- 1. The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:00 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Paul, Fejt, Santoy, Polashek, Avila and Laureto. Absent: Boyajian. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Laureto, to excuse Alderman Boyajian. Then motion carried.
- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was given for the family of Anne Pyshny, beloved mother of City of Berwyn ESDA Representative Greg Pyshny; and for the men and women protecting our safety on the streets of Berwyn, in the Armed Forces and for all Veterans.
- 3. The open forum portion of the meeting was announced. North Berwyn District 98 Band Director, Tom Chester spoke regarding the accomplishments of the band at Lincoln Middle School and requested a fund raising to help their expenses as they go to Disney World for their next endeavors.

The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
