MINUTES BERWYN CITY COUNCIL FEBRUARY 28, 2012

- 1. The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:00 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Skryd, Santoy, Avila and Laureto. Absent Polashek Thereafter, Avila made a motion seconded by Boyajian to excuse Alderman Polashek. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was had for the family of Ava Reyna, Granddaughter of Louise Sommese, former Deputy City Clerk, the family of Peter G. Eleutari, WWII Veteran and beloved Grandfather of Detective Michael Fellows and for the Men and Women on the streets of Berwyn protecting our safety, along with the Men and Women in the Armed Forces.
- 3. The Open Forum portion of the meeting was announced. Berwyn resident Sandi Van, spoke about two events sponsored by the Berwyn Public Library.
