- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. A moment of silence was given for the safety of the men and women protecting us on the streets of Berwyn, for those who are in the Armed Forces, and for all Veterans who have served.
- 3. The Open Forum portion of the meeting was announced. Ruiz invited all to attend a 6th Ward bar-b-que on July 19th at 6:30 pm at the Italian American Civic Organization. Ramirez announced a 2nd Ward meeting on June 27th at 7:30 pm at Unity Lutheran Church. Reardon announced a 3rd Ward meeting on July 19th at 6:30 pm tentatively at Proska Park. 

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT FOR A DAYCARE CENTER USE WITHIN THE C-4 CORRIDOR COMMERCIAL ZONING DISTRICT AT THE ADDRESS COMMONLY KNOWN AS 3833 S. HARLEM AVENUE, ILLINOIS - JOYCE LANE, D/B/A JUMP FOR JOY

WHEREAS, a request (the "Application") seeking a special use permit to operate a daycare center in the existing building located at 3833 S. Harlem Avenue, Berwyn, Illinois (the "Subject Property"), in the C-4 Corridor Commercial Zoning District, was filed by Petitioner Joyce Lane, d/b/a Jump for Joy (the "Applicant") with the City of Berwyn; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant seeks to redevelop the existing building on the Subject Property into a daycare center. A daycare center use is a regulated use at that location and requires a special use permit in order to operate within the C-4 Corridor Commercial Zoning District, per Section 1244.02 of the Zoning Code of the City of Berwyn ("Zoning Code"); and

WHEREAS, the Subject Property is legally described in **Exhibit A** attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Application has been referred to the Zoning, Planning and Development Commission of the City ("Commission") and has been processed in accordance with the Zoning Code, as amended; and

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2018, the Commission held a public hearing on the Application pursuant to notice thereof given in the manner required by law, and, after considering all of the testimony and evidence presented at the public hearing, the Commission recommended approval of the Application by a vote of 7-0, all as set forth in the Findings and Recommendation of the Commission in this matter ("Findings and Recommendation"), a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit B**; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City has duly considered the Findings and Recommendation of the Commission, and all of the materials, facts and circumstances affecting the Application, and, in accordance with the Findings and Recommendation of the Commission, find that the Application satisfies the standards set forth in Section 1252.03(C)(4) of the Zoning Code relating to special use permits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Berwyn, Cook County and State of Illinois, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: <u>Incorporation</u>. Each whereas paragraph set forth above is incorporated by reference into this Section 1.

Section 2: Approval of Special Use Permit for a Daycare Center. The City Council, acting pursuant to the authority vested in it by the laws of the State of Illinois and the Zoning Code, hereby approve and adopt the Findings and Recommendation of the Zoning, Planning and Development Commission, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit B, and incorporate such Findings and Recommendation by reference as if fully set forth herein. The City Council further approves a special use permit for a daycare center to locate in the C-4 Corridor Commercial Zoning District on the Subject Property located at 3833 S. Harlem Avenue, Berwyn, Illinois, as legally described in Exhibit A.

<u>Section 3</u>: <u>Violation of Condition or Code</u>. Any violation of any term or condition stated in this Ordinance or of any applicable code, ordinance, or regulation of the City shall be grounds for the immediate rescission by the City Council of the approvals made in this Ordinance.

Section 4: Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances. Each section, paragraph, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable, and if any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the unconstitutionality or invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision. All ordinances, resolutions or orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

<u>Section 5</u>: <u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND RECOMMENDATION OF THE CITY OF BERWYN ZONING, PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION TO THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL

ZPDC No. 18-04 June 20, 2018

APPLICATION: Request For a Special Use to Locate a Daycare Center

Use Within the C-4 Corridor Commercial Zoning District, at the Address Commonly Known as 3833 S. Harlem

Avenue, Berwyn, Illinois.

PETITIONER: Joyce Lane, d/b/a Jump for Joy

PROPERTY: 3833 S. Harlem Avenue, Berwyn, Illinois (the "Property")

SUMMARY OF REQUEST AND RECOMMENDATION: The City of Berwyn has received a request from Joyce Lane, d/b/a Jump for Joy ("Petitioner") for a special use permit to locate a daycare center in an existing building at the property commonly known as 3833 S. Harlem Avenue, in the C-4 Corridor Commercial Zoning District. A daycare center use requires a special use permit in order to operate within the C-4 Corridor Commercial Zoning District, per Section 1244.02 of the Zoning Code of the City of Berwyn ("Zoning Code").

Following a public hearing held on June 20, 2018, the City of Berwyn Zoning, Planning and Development Commission recommended approval of the requested special use permit on a vote of seven (7) in favor and none (0) opposed.

BACKGROUND: On the Property is an existing vacant building that previously housed a law firm. Petitioner proposes to locate and operate a daycare center within the building.

Staff determined that a special use permit was required pursuant to Section 1244.02 of the Zoning Code, in order to operate a daycare center use within the C-4 Corridor Commercial Zoning District. Petitioner then filed an application requesting that the Zoning, Planning and Development Commission grant a special use permit to allow the proposed use at the Property.

PUBLIC HEARING: At the public hearing on the special use permit request, the Petitioner, Joyce Lane, testified and presented on behalf of Jump for Joy.

The Petitioner incorporated Jump for Joy Childcare Academy South, Corp. on June 27, 2018. Jump for Joy opened its current location at 7115 Roosevelt Rd, Berwyn, Illinois, in 2011. Petitioner's business focuses on providing quality childcare. After nine years at the 7115 Roosevelt Road location, the Petitioner has outgrown the space. Petitioner

continues to receive inquiries and has a wait list of families seeking daycare services. Petitioner seeks to open a second location for Jump for Joy at 3833 S. Harlem Avenue, in order to provide daycare services to more children.

The hours of operation for the proposed second location would be Monday to Friday until 8:00 p.m. The business would be closed on Saturdays and Sundays. The proposed daycare center for 3833 S. Harlem Avenue would accommodate seventy (70) to seventy-five (75) children and twelve (12) full time employees. The daycare center will also employ four (4) to five (5) part-time employees. The children would range from ages six (6) weeks to twelve (12) years old. The Petitioner has received temporary approval from the Department of Children and Family Services to operate the daycare center.

The Property where the Petitioner proposes to locate Jump for Joy in is a 13,000 square feet lot located in the C-4 Corridor Commercial Zoning District. The single-story existing office building on the property is 6,240 square feet. Currently, the building includes a reception area, offices, and two bathrooms.

Petitioner has a construction budget of \$45,000. All remodeling of the building will be on the interior. The Petitioner intends to remove three walls to create larger interior space and possibly perform construction regarding the building's kitchen and bathroom. The Petitioner plans to install a playground outside on the Property. This second Daycare location would give Petitioner additional space to provide Daycare services to interested families.

Exhibits marked during the course of the Public Hearing included: **City Group Exhibit 1**, which consisted of the published legal notice for the public hearing, and accompanying Certification of Publication, as well as the full application for the relief sought by Petitioner and supporting materials.

There being no further questions or members of the public wishing to speak on the application, the Public Hearing was closed.

The members of the Zoning, Planning and Development Commission each then in turn expressed their views on the proposed special use permit. The Area Investigator appointed in this matter was Zoning, Planning and Development Commission Member Catherine Norden. Ms. Norden discussed her investigation and provided a thorough written report summarizing her investigation.

Member Norden made a motion, seconded by Member Miller, to approve the special use requested by Petitioner. The Zoning, Planning, and Development Commission recommended that the City Council approve the special use requested by Petitioner on a vote of seven (7) in favor and none (0) opposed.

It is noted that the Zoning, Planning and Development Commission made a request to Petitioner for a copy of the lease for the Property, and corporate documents relating to Jump for Joy Childcare Academy South, Corp. Those documents have since been received.

FINDINGS: The Zoning, Planning, and Development Commission makes the following Findings as to the proposed Special Use:

- (A) The proposed special use and development will not, under the circumstance of the particular case, endanger the health, safety, comfort, convenience and general welfare of the public. The Zoning, Planning and Development Commission found that the proposed use would benefit the general community and property values in the vicinity by providing needed quality daycare services to members of the community.
- (B) The proposed special use is compatible with the character of adjacent properties and other property within the immediate vicinity of the proposed special use. The Petitioner presented evidence that the nature of the daycare center is compatible with the other small businesses in the vicinity of the proposed daycare center. None of the particular features of the proposed daycare center were determined to be incompatible with the surrounding businesses.
- (C) The proposed special use will not impede the normal and orderly development and improvement of adjacent properties and other property within the immediate vicinity of the proposed special use. The area is already fully developed. The Petitioner submitted testimony that the property will not affect or impede the use of adjacent properties. There is a large parking lot adjacent to the building which can accommodate approximately twenty (20) vehicles. Ten (10) of the parking spots will be designated for parking and the other ten (10) will be converted into a playground for the children attending the Daycare. The parking lot is accessible on Harlem Avenue and by an alleyway abutting the rear of the property. Petitioner also stated that the building would have multiple exits, and that appropriate drop-off and pick—up procedures within the existing parking lot will be implemented so as to not obstruct traffic or impede adjacent properties.
- (D) The proposed special use will be provided with adequate utilities, access roads, drainage, and/or other necessary facilities. The Zoning, Planning and Development Commission received testimony that the Petitioner will install a fire and sprinkler system. Other utilities already exist.
- (E) The proposed special use is consistent with the intent of the Comprehensive Plan, the Zoning Code, and the other land use policies of the City. The Zoning, Planning and Development Commission found that the special use permit for a daycare center will be consistent with the intent of the Comprehensive Plan, the Zoning Code, and other land use policies of the City. Pursuant to §1242.02(A)(4) of the Zoning Code, the C-4 Corridor Commercial

Zoning District is established to accommodate moderate-scale, auto-oriented commercial development primarily along Harlem and Ogden Avenues that serves Berwyn and surrounding communities. The C-4 District allows commercial, office, and institutional uses, as well as multi-family uses. The proposed use of a daycare center will be in harmony with the general and specific purposes for which the Zoning Code was enacted, and for which the regulations of the C-4 District were established, and with the general intent of the Comprehensive Plan because it will provide a commercial use that is beneficial to the community as a whole.

RECOMMENDATIONS: Based upon the foregoing Findings, the Zoning, Planning, and Development Commission, by a vote of seven (7) in favor and none (0) opposed, recommends to the Mayor and City Council that the special use permit requested by Petitioner to locate a daycare center in an existing building in C-4 Corridor Commercial Zoning District, at the address commonly known as 3833 S. Harlem Avenue, Berwyn, Illinois, be approved.

The City was presented with the opportunity to create a Stormwater Management Plan through the support of the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning's (CMAP) Local Technical Assistance (LTA) program. The LTA program provides assistance to communities in the form of staff time and experience.

The Stormwater Management Plan was developed over a nine-month period, beginning in October 2017 and concluding in July 2018. The project was guided by a steering committee made up of representatives of the Public Works Department, Zoning, Emergency Management, Metropolitan Water Reclamation District, Illinois Department of Transportation, and facilitated by the Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning (CMAP).

The Stormwater Management Plan has been prepared to assist the City in identifying areas at a higher risk of urban flooding, prioritize land use and green infrastructure solutions, highlight locations for further engineering study, and recommend city-wide policies to mitigate stormwater issues.

I am Rob Pabon a Berwyn resident and community organizer. I am writing to request a permit for an open-air event. Our hope is that residents, clergy, city leadership and families can peacefully march in protest of the current administration's policies on separating and detaining families after they cross the border. Our group believes these practices to be cruel to families and would like the opportunity to walk in solidarity to show our support for those who have been unfairly treated.

The walk would begin at Hett Park with a short prayer/opening statement and proceed down Highland Ave south toward Cermak Rd.
