1. The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:00 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Fejt, Santoy, Polashek, Avila and Laureto. Absent: None.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was given for the family of Kenneth E. Pahlke, former Berwyn EMS Coordinator and for the men and women protecting our safety on the streets of Berwyn, in the Armed Forces, all Veterans.
3. The open forum portion of the meeting was announced. There being no speakers, the open forum portion of the meeting was declared closed.
4. The minutes of the regular Berwyn City Council and of the Committee of the Whole meetings held on January 10, 2017 were submitted. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Laureto, to concur, approve as submitted and place same on file for audit. The motion carried by a voice vote.
5. Chapman made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to suspend the rules and bring forward agenda item F-1. The motion carried. Item F-1 is a Proclamation from the Mayor recognizing Luna Iovinelli for her dedicated service to the City of Berwyn and extended best wishes on her well-deserved retirement. 

1. Mayor Lovero called the Committee of the Whole to order at 7:00 p.m.; upon the call of the roll the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Fejt, Santoy, Avila and Laureto. Absent: Polashek. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Santoy, to excuse Alderman Polashek. The motion carried.
2. Fire Paramedic Presentation: The Mayor recognized Fire Chief O'Halloran and Deputy Chief Hayes who gave a presentation updating the City Council on EMS (Emergency Medical Services.)

Note: Alderman Polashek present at 7:03 p.m.

DC Hayes reviewed both costs and cost savings from June 2010 until current, comparing costs and savings to the outsourced service of PSI. Hayes did a cross comparison, using the actual in-house service costs versus the projected costs, as if we were still were using PSI, noting that under PSI, we had only 2 ALS (Advanced Life Support) ambulances and 1 BLS (Basic Life Support) ambulance. Since switching to the in-house service, we have had 3 ALS ambulances in service. Hayes compared the projecting cost increases from PSI, figuring it in at only a 2 1/2% yearly increase for PSI services, (noting that PSI was increasing at a 3% yearly rate up until 2010.) Hayes stated the estimated cost savings to the City of Berwyn since mid-2010 was \$1,234,655.34, almost three times the projected savings at the time when the Fire Department originally made the proposal to switch to an in-house ambulance service, also noting that this was aided by the incoming new Probationary Firefighter/Paramedics salaries staying the same for their first 5 years on the job. Hayes also noted that since 2016, the Berwyn Fire Department brought maintenance of their vehicles in-house as well, stating that on staff Firefighter William Glaser obtained a Certified Emergency Vehicle Mechanics certification and now route maintenance and repairs are being done in-house, resulting in a \$50,000 savings over the budgeted amount for 2016 for vehicle maintenance and a savings of \$22,000 a year, just on routine maintenance of oil changes, filters, etc.

3. The Mayor introduced Berwyn Development Corporation Executive Director, Anthony Griffin and Amy Crowther, Director of Chamber Services, regarding agenda item E-2, the 2017 City of Berwyn Integrated Marketing Campaign, who reviewed same for the City Council. Crowther presented results from the 2016 "Why Berwyn" campaign and compared the 10 year campaign goals, the campaign influence and the overall exposure. Crowther reviewed the local

impact, which included Berwyn topping the median income growth for Cook County at 10.8% that outpaced the nation's 4% growth and that of our neighboring Oak Park who had only a 8.9% and the City of Chicago who had a 2.2% growth rate. Since the start of the campaign in the pre-recession of 2007, Berwyn's annual sales tax volume has grown 47%, to \$30.6 million. It has also helped Berwyn's annual residential investment growth to approximately 71% since 2007, \$24.8 million in 2016 alone. Finally, Crowther reviewed the public awareness of Berwyn from the campaign and the "#NothingLikeASuburb" has captured the intended audience's attention, spoken to their values and has driven action, noting "It's time to hone in further on what is to capture the millennial market."

The BDC is seeking approval of the 2017 marketing campaign budget.

4. There being nothing further for the open Committee of the Whole, the Mayor asked for a motion to close the Committee of the Whole for pending litigation. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Laureto, to close the Committee of the Whole at 7:26 p.m. The motion carried.
5. Avila made a motion in Closed Session, seconded by Santoy, to re-open the Committee of the Whole at 7:45 p.m. The motion carried.
6. Thereafter, Boyajian made a motion, seconded by Laureto, to adjourn the Committee of the Whole at 7:45 p.m. The motion carried.



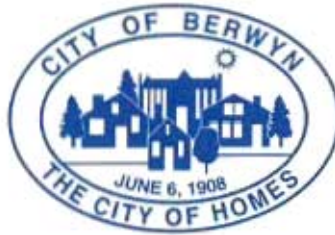

Report:

The Berwyn Historic Preservation Commission held a public hearing on January 19, 2017, which was publicized as required by the Berwyn Historic Preservation Ordinance. Five of the seven active members of the Commission were present:

Emilio Padilla, Chair
Edward Brown

Alicia Ruiz

The subject of the hearing was the nomination of the Charles W. Smith house, located at 3441 - 3437 Home Avenue, as a Berwyn Historic Landmark. Following is a report on those proceedings:

The Chair of the Commission, Emilio Padilla, opened the proceedings and reviewed the procedures for conducting the public hearing. The Chair then opened the floor to the nominating party for a brief presentation, followed by questions from the Commission and public comments. There were several questions and comments by the nominators, owner, residents and Commissioners which lead to a discussion regarding the historic significance of the house. The Commission then voted to accept the nomination, with all five members present voting to recommend that the Charles W. Smith at 3441 - 3437 Home Avenue be designated as a Berwyn Historic Landmark.

Based on the evidence presented at the public hearing, the Berwyn Historic Preservation Commission recommends that City Council designate the house at 3441 Home Avenue,

including the adjacent lot on 3437 Home Avenue, as a Berwyn Historic Landmark. We find that the building satisfies the following Criteria for designation as a Berwyn Historic Landmark according to the Berwyn Historic Preservation Ordinance:

-Significance as an example of the architectural, cultural, economic, historic or social development or heritage of the city, the state or the United States. "Significance" means the relative importance of the property when viewed in the property's architectural, cultural, economic, historic or social context. (criterion 1)

-Identification with a person or persons who significantly contributed to the architectural, cultural, economic, historic or social heritage, or other aspects of the City, the State, or the United States. (criterion 3)

-Embodiment of those distinguishing characteristics of significant architectural type, or style, or engineering specimen. "Significant" means the relative importance of the architectural type, or style, or engineering specimen. (criterion 5)

-Identification as the work of a builder, designer, architect, craftsman, engineer or landscape architect who individual work is significant in the development of the city, the state or the United States. "Significant" means the relative importance of the builder, designer, architect, craftsman, engineer or landscape architect. (criterion 6)

-Representation of an architectural, cultural, economic, historic or social theme, style or period, expressed in distinctive areas, districts, places, buildings or structures that may or may not be contiguous. (criterion 8)

A summary of the evidence presented at the hearing, which provides information about the history and design of the Charles W. Smith House can be found in the nomination form, attached.

Recommendation:

The Commission therefore recommends that the City Council designate 3441 – 3437 Home Avenue as a Berwyn Historic Landmark pursuant the Berwyn Historic Preservation Ordinance. That section holds that within 30 days of receiving this Report and Recommendation,

City Council shall either designate the historic landmark or reject the nomination by a simple majority vote of the full Council. In making this determination, the City Council shall apply the designation standards set forth in Section 1478.04 above and shall give due consideration to the record of the public hearing(s), and findings and recommendations of the Commission set forth in the Commission's resolution and report and may take public testimony with regard to the same. Upon a majority vote of the City Council to approve designation, the City Council shall enact an ordinance designating the historic landmark, which ordinance shall provide that the newly designated historic landmark shall be the subject to the provisions of Chapter 1478 of the City Code.

ORDINANCE NO.: _____

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE VICTORIAN HOME AND ADJACENT LOT AT 3441-37 HOME AVENUE, AS A HISTORIC LANDMARK, PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 1820 OF THE BERWYN CITY CODE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 1820 of the Berwyn Code of Ordinances (the "*Historic Preservation Ordinance*") provides rules and procedures for designating Historic Landmark and Districts within the City of Berwyn; and

WHEREAS, the Berwyn Historic Preservation Ordinance gives the Historic Preservation Commission (the "*Commission*") responsibility to investigate, review and recommend to the Berwyn City Council those structures or districts that have significant historical, cultural, architectural or aesthetic value as part of the heritage of the City of Berwyn, the State of Illinois, or the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Commission received and accepted an application for designation of the Victorian home and adjacent lot at 3441-37 Home Avenue, Berwyn, Illinois, as a Historic Landmark; and

WHEREAS, the Commission held a public hearing pursuant to the requirements of the Historic Preservation Ordinance on January 19, 2017 to consider the designation of the Berwyn National Bank Building as a Historic Landmark; and

WHEREAS, the Commission unanimously recommended to the City Council on January 20, 2017 that the Victorian home and adjacent lot at 3441-37 Home Avenue represents a structure that has significant historical, cultural, architectural and aesthetic value as part of the heritage of the City of Berwyn, the State of Illinois, and the United States;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1. Findings. Based upon City Council's review of the application, the Resolution and Report of the Commission, and the designation standards set forth in Section 1820.06, the City Council makes the following affirmative determination: the Victorian home and adjacent lot at 3441-37 Home Avenue, Berwyn, Illinois, embodies significant historical, cultural, architectural, and aesthetic value as part of the heritage of the City of Berwyn, the State of Illinois, and the United States.

Section 2. Adoption. The Victorian home and adjacent lot at 3441-37 Home Avenue shall hereafter be designated as a Historic Landmark pursuant to the Historic Preservation Ordinance, and subject to the provisions therein.

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file with the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois a certified copy of this designation ordinance.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.



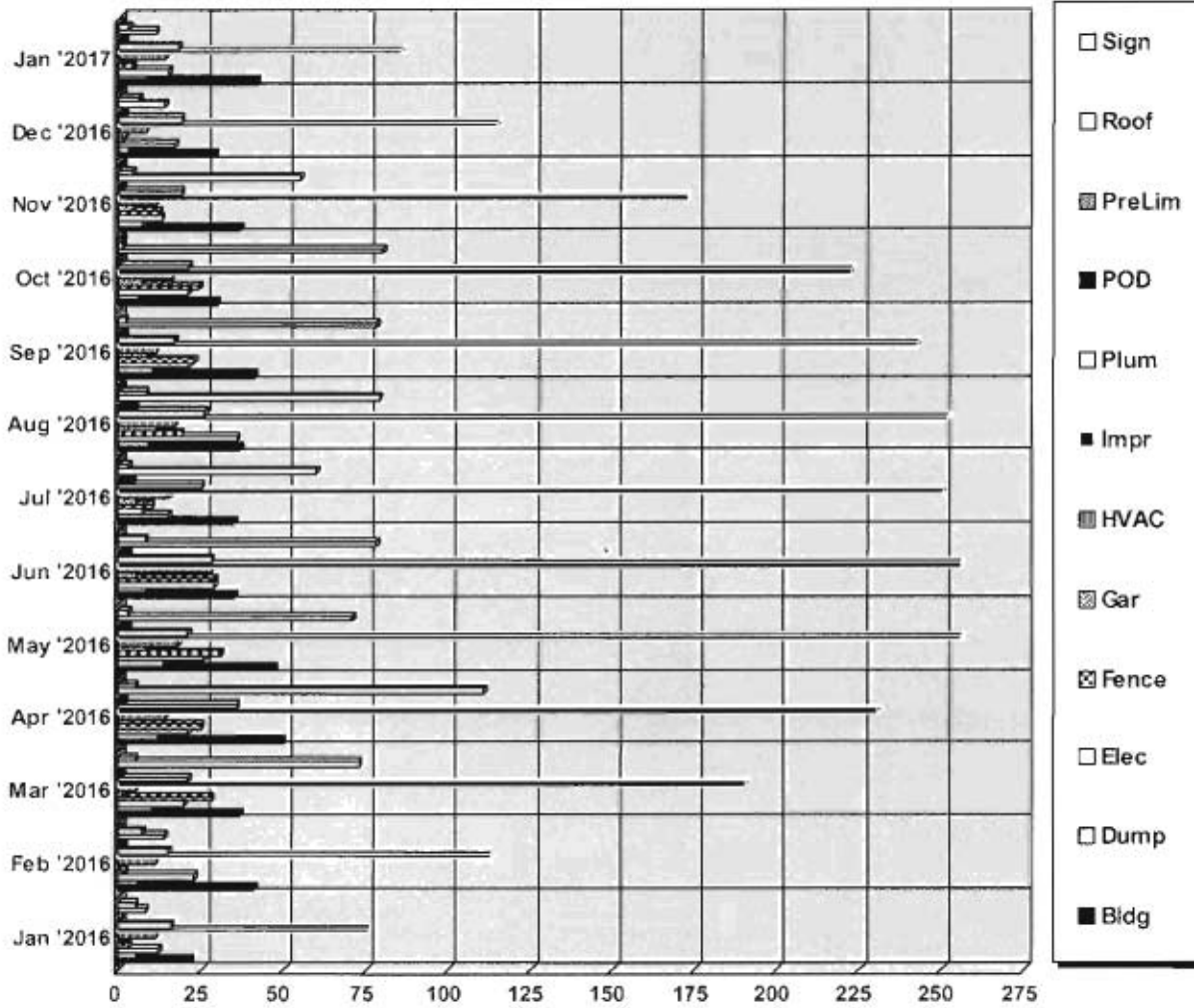
