1. The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:00 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Fejt, Santoy, Polashek, Avila and Laureto.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was given, after the Mayor asked to keep all the Police men and women in the world and especially those in Dallas, in our thoughts and prayers, along with all first responders.
3. The open forum portion of the meeting was announced. Richard Toman stated he was honored and thanked everyone for the recent proclamation he received.
4. The minutes of the regular Berwyn City Council and of the Committee of the Whole meetings held on June 28, 2016 were submitted. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Chapman, to concur, approve as submitted and place same on file for audit. The motion carried by a voice vote.
