MINUTES BERWYN CITY COUNCIL February 10, 2015

- 1. The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:00 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Fejt, Santoy, Polashek, Avila and Laureto. Absent: None.
- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was given for the family of Lillian Dominick, mother of Cicero's President Larry Dominick and for the men and women protecting our safety on the streets of Berwyn, in the Armed Forces and for all Veterans.
- 3. The open forum of the meeting was announced. There being no speakers, the open forum portion of the meeting was declared closed.
- 4. Minutes of the regular Berwyn City Council meeting and the Committee of the Whole held January 27, 2015, were submitted. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Polashek, to concur, approve as submitted and place same on file for audit. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 5. Chapman made a motion, seconded by Boyajian to suspend the rules and bring forward agenda items J-6, J-8 and J-9. The motion carried by a voice vote. J-6 is a communication from Fire Chief O'Halloran regarding an Honorable Mention for Black Shift for actions at a fire at 3252 S. Maple. The Mayor read a synopsis of the fire that occurred on January 7, 2015. The Mayor then recognized Mr. Mayer, brother of the injured resident rescued from the fire, who read a statement thanking the Police Officers, Fire Department, EMT's and all that were involved. The Mayor also recognized Superintendent Dr. Kuzniewski of School District 201, who read a statement on behalf of the District 201 staff members thanking all whom were involved, noting that some of the men and women first responders were also Morton High School graduates and that the community should be proud of their commitment to serve the community from where they came from, quoting"Once a Mustang, always a Mustang." Thereafter, Chapman made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to accept as informational. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 6. Berwyn Police Chief Ritz submitted a communication regarding Medal of Valor Awards to be presented to Officers Macias, Swiecionis, Failla and Gordon for their heroic actions in the rescue of a woman from a burning apartment on January 7, 2015 without regard to their personal safety. MINUTES BERWYN CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE February 10, 2015

- 1. Mayor Lovero called the Committee of the Whole to order at 7:00 p.m.; upon the call of the roll the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Fejt, Santoy, Polashek, Avila and Laureto. Absent: None.
- 2. Depot District Design Update: The Mayor recognized representatives of Terra Engineering and Lakota Group who gave a power Point Presentation regarding the Berwyn Depot District Streetscape. The project area spans from Harlem Ave. to Ridgeland Ave. along the BNSF Rail Line on Windsor and Stanley. On Oak Park Ave. from 34th Street to 31st Street and Grove Ave. from 34th Street to 32nd Street. They presented a project overview with a project area analysis which included Defined Zones; Residential, Commercial and the Plaza Street which will be on Windsor between Grove and Oak Park Avenues. Materials include tree grates with silva cells, to promote healthier trees and permeable pavers to help manage storm water, paid for through the \$750,000 Illinois Green Infrastructure Grant. Site furniture includes benches, trash receptacles and bike racks, along with moveable concrete planters and curb planters with anti graffiti coating. Street lighting upgrades to create consistency throughout the community, including pedestrian lights. Sidewalks paving will be done with scored concrete and cross walks will be either scored concrete or thermoplastic. There are plans for a centrally located electronic LED message board.

Infrastructure: Review of a new water main installation on Oak Park Ave. from 30th Street to Ogden Ave., crossing under the Oak Park Ave. railroad crossing. Plans include a new combined sewer main under the East Ave. railroad crossing, along with a segregated sewer/storm water sewer main along the BNSF to help increase sewer capacity in a major rain event.

Time table: Project slated to start in the Fall of 2015, with a 9 month for the infrastructure improvements and a 21 month over all project completion schedule. The Mayor recognized Traffic Engineer Nicole Campbell who reviewed the status of pending grant funding for the project. The City's approximate cost is 1.7 million for the streetscape and 8 million on infrastructure, with the total cost on streetscape at 7.25 million and overall project cost of approximately 15 million. The Mayor opened the floor for questions from the Aldermen and the public which included an area for newspaper boxes and/or a restricted corral area and potential for electrical outlets for tree lighting. The council questioned if grant monies are guaranteed. The Mayor responded that all are confirmed, but the IDOT loan for the infrastructure is still pending.

3. The Mayor stated that there was no further business for the Committee of the Whole asked if there were any questions on agenda items. There being none, the Mayor entertained a motion to adjourn. Thereafter, a motion was made by Boyajian, seconded by Chapman, to adjourn the Committee of the Whole at 7:45 p.m. The motion carried by a voice vote.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BERWYN CODE TO ELIMINATE CHAPTER 272, CLEAN CITY COMMISION, FROM THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES, CITY OF BERWYN, COUNTY OF COOK, STATE OF ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, the City of Berwyn (the "City") is a home rule unit of local government as is provided by Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and, as such, may exercise various powers and perform numerous functions pertaining to its government and affairs in any manner not otherwise prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council (collectively, the "Corporate Authorities") have determined that it is in the best interests of the City and its residents to amend sections of the Codified Ordinances (the "Code") that it has deemed unnecessary; and

WHEREAS, based upon the foregoing, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, advisable and in the best interests of the City and its residents to rescind Chapter 272, by eliminating Section 272.01, 272.02, 272.03, 272.04 and 272.05, of the Code as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Berwyn, County of Cook, State of Illinois, in the exercise of the City's home rule powers, as follows:

- **Section 1.** The statements set forth in the preambles to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are incorporated into this Ordinance as if set forth in full.
- **Section 2.** Chapter 272 Clean City Commission, of the Code is hereby rescinded as follows, by eliminating Section 272.01, 272.02, 272.03, 272.04 and 272.05.

- **Section 3.** The officers, employees and/or agents of the City shall take all action necessary or reasonably required to carry out, give effect to and consummate the amendment contemplated by this Ordinance and shall take all action necessary in conformity therewith.
- **Section 4.** All prior actions of the City's officials, employees and agents with respect to the subject matter of this Ordinance are hereby expressly ratified.
- Section 5. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and should any provision of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect.
- **Section 6.** All ordinances, resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.
- Section 7. This Ordinance shall be effective ten (10) calendar days after a full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance is published in pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.
