1. The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:00p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Fejt, Santoy, Polashek, Avila and Laureto.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was given for the family of Celestino Aguilar, grandfather of Jeannette Rendon, supervisor of the Collector's Office; Richard Russell, father of Firefighter Bill Glazer; Ron Hurst of Hurst Jewelers and for the men and women protecting our safety on the streets of Berwyn and in the Armed Forces.
3. The Open Forum portion of the meeting was announced. Alderman Laureto thanked all who attended the Green Mile Walk/Pub Crawl and for the support from the Police and Fire Departments. Clerk Pavlik introduced the new Deputy Clerk, Lillian Guerrier and asked to keep Deputy Clerk Linda Degutis who was hospitalized. 



March 25, 2014**

1. Mayor Lovero called the Committee of the Whole to order at 7:01 p.m.; upon the call of the roll the following responded present: Chapman, Paul, Fejt, Polashek and Laureto. Thereafter, Laureto made a motion, seconded by Polashek, to excuse Alderman, Boyajian, Santoy and Avila. The motion carried by a voice vote.
2. Insurance renewal, item F-3 on the council agenda. The Mayor recognized Vincent Bertuca, the authorized insurance broker for the city, who reviewed the proposed 2014-2015 health insurance renewal. Bertuca reported a 1.7% decrease in premium costs with Blue Cross/Blue Shield. Bertuca stated there was a 5.5% increase in Aetna Dental due to being able to negotiate freeze for a proposed larger increase in 2012-2013 and 2013-2014, with a 5.5% capped increase for this year, which was a substantial overall savings. The Administration is working towards an employee assist program per union contracts. Bertuca is looking into an optional flexible dental program for the future, which will also hold down costs. The Mayor thanked Mr. Bertuca for once again negotiating with the insurance companies on the city's behalf and being able to reduce insurance costs.
3. The Mayor introduced Asst. Fire Chief Molinaro who reviewed item J-8, a request for increase base rate fees for ambulance service. Molinaro stated the fees have not increased since 2008 and they now needs to be adjusted for the new Medicare/Medicaid covered allowances and private insurance companies covered allowances.
4. Chapman questioned the proper motions needed to approve item J-4 capital Approval Plan (CIP Local Technical Assistance (LTA). Evan Summers, Asst. City Administrator, answered adopting the resolution will enact the memorandum of understanding as well.
5. Alderman Fejt questioned item I-1, a request to hire additional blight inspectors from Alderman Laureto and if this will be further discussed in committee. Laureto stated her motion would be to refer the matter to the Budget Committee for input.

Dear Mayor and City Council,

The Berwyn Development Corporation's (BDC) Board of Directors recommend approval of the below specified TIF monies regarding Familia Fresh Market's project costs.

TIF assistance will be applied to rehabilitation of the 12,000 sq. ft. building. Total costs for the project are estimated at over \$600,000. The applicant successfully operated in Cermak Plaza for several years prior to closing 3 years ago due to management not renewing their lease. They feel they have a solid following in Berwyn and had been looking for another potential location in town since their closing. They will have 25 employees of which 10 will be full-time and 15 part-time. The current location was selected because of the available property and the recognized need in the Depot District area. A revenue forecast shows that the business would produce \$631,165 in local tax revenue over the next five years.

Based on this information, the City Council is being asked to approve TIF monies to pay only the eligible costs associated with this project up to a maximum of \$100,000; \$50,000 paid in 2014, and \$50,000 paid no later than the fourth (4th) quarter of 2015. Approval is contingent upon the applicant receiving all appropriate City permits. Funding is not to exceed total property and sales tax yield.

With the consent of City Council, Familia Fresh Market can commence work on their project and contribute to the revitalization efforts taking place in the Depot District.

BDC STAFF TIF APPLICATION ANALYSIS

Familia Fresh Market - 3308 Oak Park Ave.

Summary of Project:

The applicant, Familia Fresh Market, is requesting TIF funds for the build out of their commercial space in order to establish a new business. The TIF scope of work includes signage, doors, storefront glass, painting, plumbing and electrical. The applicants submitted a Tier II TIF application. To this extent, the applicant is requesting TIF funds for assistance at this location in order to fill in the needed gap.


The applicant is proposing to renovate this approximately 12,000 sq. ft. building which sits on approximately 23,000 sq. ft. of land. Familia Foods successfully operated in Cermak Plaza for several years prior to closing 3 years ago due to management not renewing their lease. They feel they have a solid following in Berwyn and had been looking for another potential location in town since their closing. They will employ 25: 10 full-time and 15 part-time. The current location was selected because of the available property and the recognize need in the Depot District area. The proposed use is compatible with current zoning regulations for the property. The property's PIN is 16-31-127-052-0000. The space, which formerly housed a grocer, has been vacant for several years.

Past TIF Funding:

The proposed project site has not received TIF funding in the past and therefore complies with the BDC TIF policy referred to below.

17. **Limit on TIF Funding:** Properties within a TIF district are limited to one (1) approved TIF application per year and two (2) approved TIF applications in five (5) years.

Summary of Costs:

Projects seeking TIF assistance for build-out costs can be given funding for the needed work in order to establish a business by filling in the needed gap. Signage, doors, storefront glass, painting, plumbing and electrical are eligible TIF expenses. According to the applicant's estimates, the total TIF eligible costs are \$226,239.00. The BDC's independent contractor estimated the same work at \$170,085.50. Total owner work, which has either already been completed or is to be completed prior to the lease being signed, is estimated at \$131,665.00. The independent contractor estimates total work on the project to equal \$605,414.02. The applicants have \$303,270.28 in equipment costs, which they will pay for with a new loan.

Needs Analysis:

The proposed renovations would help the applicant with necessary improvements to open a grocery store. The necessary full build-out cost amount would tie up critical operating capital, and could potentially create a cash flow crisis; therefore, they are seeking consideration of TIF funds. According to the supplied income statement, net ordinary income is negative the first two years of operation. The applicants have a line of credit with Citizens Community Bank for the equipment costs. The applicant's financial participation with Citizens Community Bank has been verified by BDC staff.

Redevelopment Plan Goals and Objectives:

The goals of the TIF district Redevelopment Plan which the project supports include:

A. GENERAL GOALS

1. An improved quality of life in the Project Area and the City by eliminating the influences and manifestations of physical and economic deterioration and obsolescence within the Project Area.
2. An environment within the Project Area which will contribute more positively to the health, safety and general welfare of the City, and preserve or enhance the value of properties adjacent to the Project Area.
3. An increased real estate and sales tax base for the City and other taxing districts having jurisdiction over the Project Area.

B. DEVELOPMENT AND DESIGN OBJECTIVES

2. Maintain and expand the range of retail and commercial service activities available within the Project Area;
3. Encourage the corrective maintenance of properties in poor condition;
5. Ensure safe and convenient vehicular access to, and adequate parking in, all commercial and industrial areas;
7. Improve the image and appearance of all existing commercial and industrial areas;

A. REDEVELOPMENT OBJECTIVES

3. Strengthen the economic well-being of the Project Area and the City by increasing taxable values.

Compliance with BDC TIF Design Guidelines:

There are no exterior renovations because this is land acquisition only; therefore, it complies with the BDC TIF Design Guidelines. The Downtown Commission did review the proposed signage and façade renderings and agrees with the color choices and design.

Current Balance of the Respective TIF District:

The Depot TIF program fund balance for 2014 will be \$150,000. The needed funds for the project are available.

Recommendation:

It is the recommendation of BDC staff that the requested TIF application of Familia Fresh Market be approved with the following stipulations.

1. Project participation by the TIF district as determined by the TIF Commission.
2. The applicant will not receive any TIF monies prior to obtaining proper City permits.
3. Funding not to exceed total property and sales tax yield.
4. Payment of 50% in FY2014 and 50% in the 1st quarter of FY2015.

Dear Mayor and City Council,

The Berwyn Development Corporation's (BDC) Board of Directors recommend approval of the below specified incentive monies regarding Torres Fresh Market's initial start-up costs.

Assistance will be applied to an enhanced initial marketing and advertising of the applicant's new business. Total costs of the project incurred by ownership including site acquisition, construction and F&E are \$3,378,000. The applicants are established and proven grocers who successfully operate four additional supermarkets in the Chicagoland area. They targeted the current location as they believe they are entering an underserved market on 26th street and intend to provide a much needed local grocer to the neighborhood residents. They plan to have at least 50 employees of which 30 are expected to be full-time and 20 part-time. A revenue forecast shows that the business would produce \$768,481 in local tax revenue over the next five years.

Based on this information, the City Council is being asked to approve incentive monies to assist in the initial enhanced marketing and advertising campaign in the form of a sales tax rebate. It is proposed that Torres Fresh Market receive a 40% share of sales tax over a two (2) year period, paid quarterly and not to exceed \$75,000 over the two year term.

With the consent of City Council, Torres Fresh Market can implement enhanced marketing and advertising plans for their new store to ensure the success of a much needed grocer for the 26th street corridor.

The applicant, Torres Fresh Market, is requesting incentive funds for initial start-up costs related to enhanced marketing and advertising of their new business. The goal is to establish awareness in the community and bring customers to their new store on 26th Street. To this extent, the applicant is requesting a one-time incentive in the amount of \$105,000.

The applicant has purchased the real estate and is undergoing renovations on the 15,700 sq. ft. building which sits on approximately 33,500 sq. ft. of land and includes a parking lot to serve up to 35 vehicles. The Torres Fresh Market owners, Adolfo and Martha Linares, are established and proven grocers who successfully operate four additional supermarkets in the Chicagoland area.

The Linares' targeted this location as they believe they are entering an underserved market on 26th street and intend to provide a much needed local grocer to the neighborhood residents.

The property consists of 10 lots with a PIN range of: 16-29-127-031-0000 to 16-29-127-040-0000. The space was formerly tenanted by Great Western Electrical Supply, Inc.

As a result of the upcoming Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (MWRD) changes to their storm water ordinances, local municipalities are going to be required to perform certain benchmark maintenance activities. Some of those activities include cyclical cleaning of the municipal sewer system and specific cleaning of documented problem areas. I have collected hourly pricing from local firms via contracts and from hourly quotes provided during recent cleaning and televising activities.

Berwyn participates in a collective purchasing program that provides the City with access to competitive pricing for vehicles negotiated by the Northwest Municipal Conference's Suburban Purchasing Cooperative ("SPC"). City staff has determined that the SPC's purchasing policies satisfy both the City and the State's competitive bidding requirements. The SPC requested prices for Vactor sewer cleaning machines; Standard Equipment Company of Chicago, Illinois submitted the low bid for a Vactor 2100 sewer cleaning vehicle in the amount of \$324,247.

Berwyn's Finance Department performed a detailed present value analysis of potential lease-purchase arrangements for the Vactor. With an estimated useful life of 10-15 years, it would be in the best interest of the City to enter into a five year lease-purchase agreement. This method of purchase will allow the City to own the equipment while mitigating strain on the City's budget. The annual lease-purchase payment will be \$68,468 for five years; a total of \$342,340. The City has spent, on average, \$146,000 per year on private contractors to provide sewer cleaning services.

After reviewing the SPC's vendor selection, City staff determined that the Vactor 2100 satisfies all of the City's operational requirements and the acquisition of the equipment will provide our residents with a higher level of service.

Recommended Actions:

Approve the lease/purchase of a 2014 Vactor 2100 from the Northwest Municipal Conference's Suburban Purchasing Cooperative for a total of \$342,340 amortized over five years.
