## MINUTES BERWYN CITY COUNCIL August 12, 2014

- 1. The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:00 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Fejt, Polashek, Santoy, Avila and Laureto.
- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was given for the family of Mary Perez, grandmother of Berwyn Police Officer Judith Velazquez. Also a moment for the men and women protecting our safety on the streets of Berwyn, in the Armed Forces and all Veterans. The Mayor spoke about the Moving Wall which showed pride and honor for Berwyn.
- 3. The Open Forum, Ms. Rivera gave a presentation regarding the Love for Lee Fundraiser. Public Works Director informed that the BNSF rail crossing at Grove will be closed on August 22, 2014 for seven days for repairs and also repairs will be done at the Home Avenue crossing. Alderman Boyajian shared good news that the MWRD 43<sup>rd</sup> Street Levy on Des Plaines River will be repaired. Alderman Avila spoke regarding the Oak Street Health Center on Home and Cermak. Alderman Laureto thanked Frank Amaro, Jeff Janda and all the volunteers for a job well done with the Moving Wall.
- 4. Minutes of the Berwyn City Council regular meeting and Committee of the Whole held July 22, 2014, were submitted. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to concur and approve as submitted. The motion carried by a voice vote.

## MINUTES BERWYN CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE August 12, 2014

- Mayor Lovero called the Committee of the Whole to order at 6:00 p.m.; upon the call of the roll the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Fejt, Paul, Polashek, Avila and Laureto. Absent: Santoy. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Laureto, to excuse Alderman Santoy. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 2. The Mayor informed council that he received word that the Governor's office as put forth a 1.1 million grant for sewer collapse repairs. The Mayor also wished Traffic Engineer Nicole Campbell a happy birthday.
- 3. Water and Sewer Low Interest Loan: The Mayor recognized Public Works Director Robert Schiller and Traffic Engineer Nicole Campbell who gave a brief presentation of the infrastructure work for the Depot District Streetscape Project including the anticipated revenues and expenditures for the 8.1 million projects. Schiller reviewed the water main situation, sewer lines upgrades and fire hydrant upgrades in the Depot area project. Campbell reviewed the IEPA project planning check list and application process and is seeking council's authorization to apply (item J-10 on tonight's agenda.)
  - Santoy present at 6:14 p.m.

Discussion ensued regarding the terms of the loan, which will be paid over 20 years from the utility fund.

- 4. Big Hurt Brewery TIF Request: The Mayor recognized Anthony Griffin, Berwyn Development Corporation Executive Director who reviewed same (item E-1 on tonight's agenda.) Griffin stated that there is \$500,000 remaining in the Cermak TIF for the 3 remaining active projects, as well as reserves for any future tax objections. Griffin reviewed TIF eligible costs for the \$123,200 request, with a tentative completion date of mid September, early October.
- 5. Discussion regarding BYOB Ordinance: The Mayor recognized Assistant City Administrator Evan Summers who reviewed all three ordinances pertaining to establishing a BYOB licensing process.
- 6. The Mayor asked for a motion to close the Committee of the Whole for real estate and pending litigation. Thereafter, Polashek made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to close the Committee of the Whole at 6:53 p.m. The motion carried.

Dear Mayor and City Council,

The Berwyn Development Corporation's (BDC) Board of Directors recommend approval of the below specified TIF monies regarding Carol Bodden's (property owner) project costs. Ms. Bodden purchased the property in 2011.

TIF assistance will be applied to rehabilitation of the 5,844 sq. ft. building, including exterior rehabilitation that entails removal of the current stucco siding, restoration and replacement of brick, tuckpointing, doors and windows improvements. Total costs for the project are estimated at over \$200,000. The building is a mixed use building consisting of three (3) rental apartments and four (4) commercial units of approx. 800 SF, 960 SF, 1,100 SF and 750 SF. All but the 750 SF unit are rented. A revenue forecast shows that the property would produce \$87,672 in local tax revenue over the next five years.

Based on this information, the City Council is being asked to approve TIF monies to pay only the eligible costs associated with this project up to a maximum of \$60,000: \$20,000 per year for the next 3 years. Approval is contingent upon the applicant receiving all appropriate City permits and full completion of the approved scope of work.

With the consent of City Council, Ms. Bodden can commence work on her project and contribute to the revitalization efforts taking place on Ogden Avenue.

## BDC STAFF TIF APPLICATION ANALYSIS Carol Bodden – 6250 Ogden Ave.

#### **Summary of Project:**

The applicant, Carol Bodden, is requesting TIF funds for redevelopment work on her mixed-use/commercial building. The TIF scope of work includes, but not limited to, exterior rehabilitation including removal of stucco siding, cleaning of brick, tuckpointing, doors and windows improvements. The applicant submitted a Tier II TIF application. To this extent, the applicant is requesting TIF funds for redevelopment work at this location in order to fill in the needed gap.

Carol Bodden has owned this property since February 2011. The building includes three (3) rental apartments and three (4) commercial units of approx. 800 SF, 960 SF, 1,100 SF and 750 SF. All units are rented but one (750 SF).

The applicant is proposing to rehab this approximately 5,844 sq. ft. 2-story commercial/residential space. The proposed work is compatible with current zoning regulations for the property. The property PIN is 16-32-122-001-0000.

#### **Past TIF Funding:**

The applicant was approved for \$94,500 in 2012, although the project never moved forward. Therefore, the proposed project site has not received TIF funding in the past and therefore complies with the stipulation below.

17. Limit on TIF Funding: Properties within a TIF district are limited to one (1) approved TIF application per year and two (2) approved TIF applications in five (5) years.

#### **Summary of Costs:**

Projects seeking TIF assistance for rehab costs can be given funding for the needed work in order to fill in the needed gap, but also have the ability to be carried on to future businesses in order to limit the need for future TIF assistance. Submitted bids include work for demolition, cleaning of brick, tuckpointing, doors and windows are eligible TIF expenses. The total TIF eligible work equals \$207,000. The BDC had a licensed and experienced general contractor review the scope of work.

#### **Needs Analysis:**

The proposed renovation would help the applicant make necessary improvements to her building in order to improve conditions for new commercial tenants. The proposed work also enhances the image of Ogden Avenue by removing an unwanted stucco façade and renovating the underlying brick. The submitted building pro-forma shows modest income but not enough to cover the full scale of the development. The applicant's financial participation has been verified by BDC staff. Should the applicant not get the requested funding, the project will be severely scaled back or not happen at all.

Promote the repair and rehabilitation of existing buildings in poor condition.


#### Design and Appearance

Contract award recommendation to the council to hire the Lakota Group to identify and Re:

recommend a historic district that qualifies for nomination as a National Register of Historic

The National Historic Nomination Ad Hoc Committee met on Wednesday, August 20 to discuss the three proposals submitted for the nomination of a Bungalow Historic District to the National Register. The committee reviewed the following three proposals:

Preservation Research Office: \$35,900

The Lakota Group: \$28,500

Ramsey Historic Consultant: \$25,000

The committee recommends the Lakota Group for approval by the City Council to complete the National Register of Historic Places Nomination. Though the Lakota Group was not the lowest bidder at \$28,500, the committee agreed that the Lakota Group's timeline, methodology for survey and inventory report, particularly their use of technology, social media, and public participation, as well as their previous experience with the City of Berwyn, make Lakota Group the preferred candidate for this project.

As previously discussed at the August 12, 2014 Council meeting, the City was awarded an Illinois Historic Preservation Agency grant of \$17,500 with a City reimbursable matching amount of \$7,500 for a total commitment of \$25,000. It should be noted that the City of Homes Organization is committed to provide the \$7,500 match, and will seek additional grant monies to help offset the municipal out of pocket cost of \$3,500. At this time, the City would only absorb the additional cost of \$3,500 unless we are able to identify other funding sources.

This honorary designation for the district will bring a much deserved recognition to Berwyn.

Recommendation: Approve a contract to hire The Lakota Group in the amount of \$28,500 to identify and recommend a historic district that qualifies for nomination as a National Register of Historic Places.

Re: Recommendation to Approve the Purchase of a State Bid Dump Truck

The City of Berwyn Public Works Department is requesting authorization to replace M-16, a 1995 Ford L8000 tandem axle dump truck (vin# 1FDYW82E2TVA02120) with a new International 4300-LP dump truck via state bid pricing. I have located the above mentioned truck to replace the L8000, which continues to be very difficult to secure repair parts for. The new vehicle is an International 4300-LP dump truck with the "standard" Illinois Department of Transportation specifications, and it is available via 2012 state bid pricing. If approved, this unit would be sent to have the dump body, hydraulics, snow plow, salt spreader and emergency lighting installed. The vehicle could be constructed, assembled and delivered in approximately 12 weeks; it will also include a full 1 year parts and labor warranty from the date of delivery. Upon completion, the new unit will be placed in service and become one of the front line responding snow removal units.

Public Works and Finance have discussed different purchasing options for this vehicle and have determined that the three year lease/purchase option with annual payments of \$36,941.14 is the best method to purchase this unit. After the processing of the third payment, the City will own this vehicle. In addition, I would request the Finance Director declare truck M-16 including a salt spreader and snow plow to be surplus and to authorize the Public Works Department to dispose of this vehicle through public auction

This unit is budgeted within the 2014 Public Works budget.

#### Recommended Actions;

Staff recommends approving the purchase of one International 4300-LP 4 X 2 dump truck with hydraulics, mounted salt spreader, body and plow to Monroe Truck Equipment and Rush Truck Center for a total of \$110,823.42


