MINUTES BERWYN CITY COUNCIL APRIL 23, 2013

- The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:00 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Santoy, Polashek and Laureto. Absent: Paul, Skryd and Avila. Thereafter, Laureto made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to excuse Alderman, Paul, Skryd and Avila. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was had for the victims of the recent flood and for the Men and Women on the streets of Berwyn protecting our safety, along with the Men and Women in the Armed Forces.
- 3. The Open Forum portion of the meeting was announced. Emergency Management Coordinator Anthony Laureto spoke regarding the recent flooding and ComEd substation in Stickney was very close to flooding, thereby causing an emergency alert and an incident command was set into motion, along with a duty desk at the Berwyn Police Station to file damage claims. Information and claim forms have also been posted to the City of Berwyn web-site.

Alderman Boyajian read a letter into record regards to the flooding of April 19, 2013, thanking all of the individuals involved from the Village of Stickney, M.W.R.D, the City of Berwyn and the City of Berwyn's Public Works Department for their collaboration in diverting the floods waters quickly encroaching Com Ed's Stickney substation and averting a catastrophic event a monumental power outage that would have affected the SW side of Chicago, Midway Airport, M.W.R.D. facility and all towns between Forest View all the way to Forest Park.

Alderman Polashek announced a wine tasting event on May 17, 2013 for 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. at the Chicagoland Czech Community Center, 6635 Cermak Road.

4. The minutes of the Berwyn City Council, the Committee of the Whole and the Public Hearing held April 10, 2013 were submitted. Thereafter, Boyajian made a motion, seconded by Chapman, to concur and approve as presented. The motion carried by a voice vote.

MINUTES PUBLIC HEARING APRIL 23, 2013

PUBLIC HEARING

RESIDENTIAL AGGREGATION FOR ELECTRIC RATES

- 1. The Public Hearing for the Residential Aggregation for Electric Rates was called to order at 5:48 p.m. City Officials and Department heads in attendance: Aldermen Polashek, Mayor Lovero, City Administrator Pabst, Asst. City Administrator Summers, PW Director Schiller and Clerk Pavlik.
- 2. Clerk Pavlik read the legal notice into record and provided an affidavit of certification of publication.
- 3. Mayor Lovero informed the public that the referendum did not pass. Clerk Pavlik stated the unofficial vote count is 1166 Yes, 1300 No, but that it will not be certified and official until April 30, 2013. Mayor recognized Evan Summers who stated that this public hearing and the public hearing of April 10, 2013, will satisfy requirements to hold two public hearings before adoption in the event a referendum regarding Electrical Aggregation passes at a later date.

4. Comments and Questions:

The Mayor asked if there were any questions or comments from the general public and/or Alderman. The Mayor recognized Berwyn resident Wayne Parthun, who stated he voted against the referendum. The Mayor recognized City Administrator Pabst who stated it is a shame the referendum failed and that it would have definitely saved Berwyn residents and small business owners dollars off their electric bills. Alderman Polashek thanked the administration for all of their hard work put into this. Evans Summers stated the city will try again to past the referendum in the March 2014 election. The Mayor went onto state he felt there may have been misleading information circulating, but that the City of Berwyn would not have profited off of this, unlike the City of Chicago that was charging an administrative fee and that all savings realized would of benefitted the customers directly. Also, the City of Berwyn would have negotiated built in cost reductions if Com Ed's rates would have dropped below the aggregated contracted amounts with the supplier.
