The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:00 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Fejt, Santoy, Polashek, Avila and Laureto. Absent: Paul. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to excuse Alderman Paul. The motion carried by a voice vote.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was had for all the fallen servicemen and women, as well to as the men and women protecting our safety on the streets in Berwyn.
3. The Open Forum portion of the meeting was announced. Alderman Laureto announced the Roosevelt Road Zombie Walk and Pub Crawl on October 26, 2013 at 6:45 p.m. Alderman Polashek thanked all those who showed up for Violets "Hope for Flowers" event. Alderman Chapman, noted the reason the Mayor missed the previous City Council Meeting was because the Mayor and Anthony Bertuca were both recognized and sworn in before the Supreme Court in Washington D.C. ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISMISSAL OF COOK COUNTY CASE NUMBER 2013 L 050495, THE ISSUANCE OF A NEW OFFER FOR THE VOLUNTARY ACQUISITION OF THE PROPERTY COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE “DOMINGUEZ PARCEL”, AND THE RE-FILING OF EMINENT DOMAIN PROCEEDINGS TO ACQUIRE THE “DOMINGUEZ PARCEL” IF VOLUNTARY NEGOTIATIONS ARE UNSUCCESSFUL

WHEREAS, the City of Berwyn (the “City”) is a home rule municipal corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the Constitution and laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, by virtue of the Constitution and laws of the State of Illinois, the City is authorized to acquire property useful, advantageous and/or desirable for municipal purposes and/or the public welfare; and

WHEREAS, the City is empowered to acquire by purchase, donation, lease or eminent domain, any and all real estate, lands, riparian estates or rights, and all other property it determines is reasonably necessary to achieve its municipal purposes and/or to promote the public welfare; and

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2011, the City adopted Ordinance Nos. 11-26, 11-27 and 11-28 respectively approving a Tax Increment Redevelopment Plan and Project for the Harlem Tax Increment Financing Project Area pursuant to the Tax Increment Allocation Redevelopment Act (65 ILCS 5/11-74.4, *et seq.*); and

WHEREAS, on March 26, 2013, the City passed and approved Ordinance No. 13-08 in which it selected, located and designated the real property legally described in **Exhibit A** attached hereto, with the common address of 7104-7108 West Cermak Road, Berwyn, Illinois 60402 (the “Dominguez Parcel”), as one of the sites to be acquired in furtherance of the Harlem Tax Increment Financing Project Area; and

WHEREAS, the Dominguez Parcel is located within the territorial limits of the City, is conveniently located within the City of Berwyn, and is in an area and of a size sufficiently large to accomplish and effectuate one or more of the municipal purposes herein described; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 13-08, the City attempted to negotiate for the voluntary purchase of the Dominguez Parcel, but because those negotiations were unsuccessful, the City filed a Complaint for Condemnation on May 17, 2013, captioned City of Berwyn v. Porfirio Dominguez, et al., Cook County Case No. 2013 L 050495 (the “Complaint”); and

WHEREAS, after the filing of the Complaint, the Defendant owner of the Dominguez Parcel filed a Traverse and Motion to Dismiss the Complaint asserting that the City did not

satisfy the jurisdictional averment of completing a bona fide attempt to agree on just compensation prior to filing the Complaint consistent with Section 30/10-5-10 of the Eminent Domain Act (735 ILCS 30/10-5-10), as further defined by Illinois case law, because the City extended an offer in an amount commensurate with the leased fee value of the property, as opposed to the fee simple value of the property; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is more cost effective, efficient and in the City's best interest, to simply dismiss the Complaint and pay the statutory dismissal fees, if any, provided for under Section 10-5-70 of the Eminent Domain Act (735 ILCS 30/10-5-70), as opposed to incurring additional fees, costs and expenses associated with further discovery and litigating the merits of the Traverse and Motion to Dismiss; and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the dismissal, the City Council continues to believe that it is necessary, desirable and in the best interest of the City for the City to acquire the Dominguez Parcel to effectuate and further the Harlem Tax Increment Redevelopment Project and Plan, as well as for those other purposes set forth herein, be it by successful new voluntary negotiations with the owner of the Dominguez Parcel, or by the exercise of eminent domain proceedings in the event that negotiations for the voluntary acquisition of the Dominguez Parcel are unsuccessful; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has thereby determined that it is necessary, desirable and in the best interest of the City to authorize its legal counsel, agents and staff to take whatever actions are necessary in order to dismiss the Complaint and pay the statutory attorney fees, costs and expenses incurred by Defendants in defense of the Complaint, if any, and to re-issue a new offer to purchase the Dominguez Parcel at its full fee simple value in an effort to voluntarily acquire the Dominguez Parcel, based upon the updated information obtained from the City's appraisal consultant; and

WHEREAS, if the new offer to purchase is not accepted by the property owner, and negotiations therefore reach an impasse, the City has determined that it is necessary, desirable and in the City's best interest to proceed with acquisition of the Dominguez Parcel by the exercise of eminent domain through the filing of new condemnation proceedings.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council and the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The City Council adopts the findings, definitions and determinations set forth in the preambles hereto as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. It is necessary, desirable and in the best interest of the City to dismiss the Complaint in Cook County Case No. 2013 L 050495, captioned City of Berwyn v. Porfirio Dominguez, et al., and the City's staff and attorneys are hereby authorized to take any and all steps that are necessary in order to do so, and to conduct all further proceedings within Cook County Case No. 2013 L 050495 to complete the dismissal and to prepare and enter all necessary documentation to effect dismissal, and to analyze and have the City pay any and all statutory expenses, fees and costs deemed recoverable by the Defendants in Cook County Case No. 2013

L 050495, as provided for under 735 ILCS 30/10-5-70 and the Illinois case law interpreting said statutory provision.

Section 3. Legal counsel for the City is hereby authorized to take all steps necessary to obtain an updated valuation for the Dominguez Parcel from the City’s appraisal consultant, and the Berwyn Development Corporation, as the designated and authorized agent of the City, is hereby authorized to extend a new offer to purchase the Dominguez Parcel to the owner of record, at the full fee simple appraised value of the Dominguez Parcel.

Section 4. If the offer is not accepted, is rejected or the Berwyn Development Corporation is otherwise unable to negotiate or successfully conclude an agreement with the owner of the Dominguez Parcel, legal counsel for the City is hereby directed and authorized on behalf of the City, to take all steps necessary to acquire the Dominguez Parcel by the filing of new eminent domain proceedings.

Section 5. That the Berwyn Development Corporation, City staff and legal counsel for the City are hereby authorized to take any and all other steps reasonably necessary to give effect and fully implement this Ordinance.

Section 6. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the City’s home rule powers.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the City Council as provided by law.

WHEREAS, the December holiday season is traditionally one of the most deadly times of the year for impaired driving; and


WHEREAS, for thousands of families across the state and the nation, holidays are a time to remember loved ones lost; and



Re: **Renewal of General Liability Insurance**

The City's general liability insurance coverage is set to expire on December 31, 2013. Staff therefore asked our independent insurance broker, T.A. Cummings, to go out for bid and solicit quotes from carriers. Our current coverage, with carrier Munich (d.b.a. Princeton E & S), has a \$10,000,000 limit of liability and a \$250,000 deductible/retention.

T.A. Cummings solicited quotes from three different carriers in addition to Munich (current carrier.) They declined to provide a quote stating that they would not be able to be competitive with Munich's quote of \$236,374 as a premium, a 3.9% increase over last year. The industry standard increase from last year is between 5 and 10%.

It is the recommendation of T.A. Cummings to renew with Munich in the amount of \$244,883 (premium of \$236,374 and surplus lines taxes and fees in the amount of \$8,509.)

Re: Contract approval for feasibility study regarding potential addition to the Police Department building

The police department was built prior to the September 11th incident. Since the event of September 11, there have been numerous safety and security requirements that should be instituted, and therefore, the current facility needs to be evaluated to identify the deficiencies and related costs. The police department has experienced functional issues pertaining to inadequate space. For example, a few of the current issues are as follows: There is only one holding cage that when in use, officers have to place other detainees in areas not designed for such purposes. Ten Sergeants share one office with two to three Sergeants on duty at any given time. There is a civilian records clerk and a sworn court officer sharing one office. The records and dispatch departments are working in a very limited environment. Storage is extremely inadequate.

To address these concerns, our intention is to apply for various grants however, in order to complete the applications, we need to have our due diligence finalized. In the past, we have hired staff associated with Lamp Inc. for various tasks. This firm has an excellent reputation and is very familiar with the project, therefore we have asked them to provide a scope of service that accomplishes our immediate goal of identifying and quantifying our space needs issue.

By accomplishing the above tasks, the City will gain benefits by reducing the owner's risk and exposure. Additionally, the above services identify upfront fees and general condition expenses associated with these types of services enabling the City to better focus on the project and provide maximum benefit for the project dollars. In addition, this information takes the guesswork out of the next steps. Similar to other engineering design projects, these services are not required by state law to be bid out. Staff has carefully evaluated the scope and has met with staff associated with Lamp Inc. The detailed scope of the project and related cost is well within the anticipated budgeted amount. This information accomplishes our goal of identifying needed information for the above mentioned grant applications.

Recommendation. Approve an amount not to exceed \$24,900 and authorize the City Administrator and City Attorney to execute a contract.



Subject: New World Systems Standard Software Maintenance Agreement

In January 2009, the City of Berwyn began using New World Systems software in the City's Finance Department to be the main financial software to provide payroll, accounts payable, budgeting, and accounting functions. Over time, the City also has added the utility billing module to its software capabilities.

On December 31, 2013, the City's software maintenance agreement will expire. The main services that New World is to perform per the new agreement are similar to the old agreement and consist of:

1. System upgrades
2. Temporary fixes to existing software
3. Revisions to licensed documentation
4. Telephone support access to City employees
5. Participation in user group meetings with other municipalities

Such an agreement with specialized software is essential to maintain in the event of system errors and malfunctions and to keep the software current with upgrades and fixes. New World Systems has submitted its renewal of the software maintenance agreement over a 5-year duration that would expire on December 31, 2018. The proposed rates are as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING SOLID WASTE COLLECTION FEES FOR THE 2014 FISCAL YEAR IN THE CITY OF BERWYN, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois (the “City”) is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs (the “Home Rule Powers”); and

WHEREAS, the City contracts with a private waste collection and disposal company, Waste Management, to provide weekly garbage collection for residential dwellings less than five units; and

WHEREAS, the City administers the collection of all such customer accounts and provides applicable billing invoices, accounting services and expends other public funds to administer the solid waste billing and collection program; and

WHEREAS, Waste Management has given the City notice that rates charged for garbage collection will be increasing by 2.0% commencing in 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained that the City Council of the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its Home Rule Powers, adopts the amended billing fee rate adjustment as established by Waste Management for weekly garbage collection in the 2014 calendar year as set forth below:

SECTION 1: That the above recitals and legislative findings are incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

SECTION 2: Fees for the collection and billing of all solid waste disposal services are hereby adjusted by an increase of 2.0% commencing on the billing cycle beginning on January 1, 2014.

SECTION 3: If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby amended or repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: Any non-preemptive state statute in conflict hereof with the ordinance is hereby superceded to the full extent of such conflict pursuant to the exercise of the Home Rule Powers of the City.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law to be effective by January 1, 2014.
