

The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:00 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Skryd, Polashek, Avila and Laureto. Absent: Santoy. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Polashek, to excuse Alderman Santoy. The motion carried by a voice vote.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was had for the family of the deceased Felix Hernandez, Marie Comella, wife of Water Department Vince Comella and for former Alderman Raymond Cox and for the Men and Women on the streets of Berwyn protecting our safety, along with the Men and Women in the Armed Forces.
3. The Open Forum portion of the meeting was announced. 



**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and the City Council have determined it is in the best interest of the City to receive CDBG funds from HUD for housing and related needs of low and moderate income persons; and

**WHEREAS**, the Community Development Dept. developed a Thirteenth Year Action Plan and Three Year Consolidated Plan for Program Year 2012 ("Thirteenth Year Action Plan"), pursuant to HUD regulations and in accordance with a Citizen Participation Plan which meets HUD's requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City developed its Thirteenth Year Action Plan to promote the development of a viable urban community, by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for low and moderate income persons, in conformance with HUD Act of 1974, as amended, and the HUD regulations applicable thereto; and

**WHEREAS**, after due deliberation the City Council finds it would be in the best interest of the CITY to approve and submit the CITY's Thirteenth Year Action Plan drafted by Department of Community Development.

That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby directed and authorized to enter into on behalf of the CITY all contracts necessary and proper to fully implemented the Thirteenth Year Action Plan including, but not limited to, all contracts receiving any allocation therein; and all contracts under the Single Family Rehab Program, and as otherwise required to implement the Thirteenth Year Action Plan.

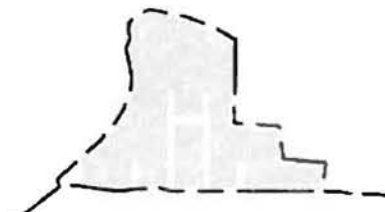


