- 1. The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:00 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Skryd, Santoy, Polashek and Laureto. Absent: Avila. Thereafter, Santoy made a motion seconded by Boyajian to excuse Alderman Avila. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was had for the family of the deceased Bernard "Bernie" Hannigan and for the Men and Women on the streets of Berwyn protecting our safety, along with the Men and Women in the Armed Forces.
- 3. The Open Forum portion of the meeting was announced. There being no speakers, the open forum portion of the meeting was closed.
- 4. The minutes of the Berwyn City Council Meeting, Committee of the Whole and Public Hearing for the 2012 Budget Appropriation Ordinance held on March 13, 2012 were submitted. Thereafter, Skryd made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to concur and approve as submitted. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 5. Item D-1, Bid Opening and Reconfiguration, Insulate, Repair and Cleaning of Existing HAVC Duct System for the South End Fire Station. MINUTES BERWYN CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MARCH 27, 2012

- Mayor Lovero called the Committee of the Whole to order at 6:05 p.m., upon the call of the roll, the following responded present. Boyajian, Paul, Skryd, Polashek, and Laureto. Absent: Chapman, Santoy and Avila. Thereafter, Alderman Skryd made a motion, seconded by Alderman Boyajian, to excuse Alderman Chapman, Alderman Santoy and Alderman Avila. The motion carried.
- Health Insurance Renewal Presentation. The Mayor introduced Vincent Bertuca, who presented the renewal protections for the period May 1, 2012 through April 30, 2013 and reviewed same. There being no questions, the Mayor thanked Mr. Bertuca for all his hard work, on behalf of the City of Berwyn, to renew the insurance coverage with a 0% percent increase.
- 3. Item J-7 on the Berwyn City Council Agenda. The Public Works Director's communication regarding, Enhanced Strom Water Detention for Proska Park. The Mayor stated that Alderman Paul had some concerns and recognized Public Works Director Robert Schiller, Jeff Janda, Berwyn Park District Executive Director, along with Commissioner of the Berwyn Park District, Frank Amaro, who were available for questions. The Mayor explained once the Berwyn Park District had the plan for Storm Water Project, it was brought to the Public Works Director and presented to the City Engineer to address overflow concerns. The Mayor stated that if this is approved tonight, then the Berwyn Park District will go back to their engineer to re-draw the plans and the Berwyn Park District will incur that cost. The communication is just an approval to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement, after the final plans go out for seal bids and quotes, then the Berwyn City Council will have to agree or disagree to approve the project once the final plans with the Intergovernmental Agreement is presented. Alderman Paul requested to see plans. Frank Amaro produced same and the Mayor referred to Public Works Director Schiller, who briefed the City Council on the Plans to date, with his suggestions and the engineer's suggestions, to enhance the original plans to avoid inundating the sewer system with run off.

The City's Engineer recommendation was to store the 100 year storm rains in a underground retention, that will run off slower, all of which is not required for the city to sign off on these plans, but the Berwyn Park District has agreed to enter into an agreement with the city to address the flood concerns. Discussion ensued regarding the details of the plans. Thereafter, there were no further questions, the Mayor stated this will be item J-7 on the City Council Agenda and will be up for a vote this evening.

There being no further business to come before the Open Committee of the Whole Meeting, the Mayor asked for a motion to go into Closed Session for Pending Litigation, Real Estate, Personnel and review of Closed Committee of the Whole Minutes. Thereafter, Polashek made a motion, seconded Skryd, to close the Committee of the Whole at 6:47 p.m. The motion carried by a voice vote.

Dear Mayor and City Council,

The applicant is requesting TIF funds for façade improvements at his new commercial space. The TIF scope of work includes a complete interior build-out consisting of plumbing, electrical, carpentry, flooring, ceiling and façade renovation. The applicants submitted a Tier II TIF application. To this extent, the applicants are requesting TIF funds for redevelopment work at this location in order to fill in the needed gap. Total TIF eligible project costs are expected to be \$81,495.37 plus city permits.

The application meets the procedural requirements of the Berwyn TIF application which was reviewed by Berwyn Development Corporation (BDC) staff and then processed for consideration. A 5-year revenue forecast shows that the business would produce \$81,660 in total tax revenue.

The BDC's Board of Directors and the Ogden/Depot TIF committee have both agreed to recommend approval of the below specified TIF monies regarding Off the Traxx's TIF eligible project costs.

Based on this information, the City Council is being asked to approve TIF monies to pay only the eligible costs associated with this project of 50% up to a maximum of \$40,000. As part of our process, BDC staff will validate work performed and eligibility prior to any payments. Furthermore, the BDC will ensure the applicant will not receive any TIF monies prior to obtaining proper City permits.

With the consent of City Council, Off the Traxx can commence work on their project and contribute to the revitalization efforts taking place in the Depot District.

Dear Mayor and City Council:

On March 8, 2012, the BDC Commercial Loan Committee provided preliminary approval of the Jack's Rental Inc loan application which would be used to: 1) payoff an existing 2nd mortgage and 2) working capital for the business. The loan request is for \$255,000. Jack's is a long standing business on 26th Street within Berwyn providing retail sales, repair, and equipment rental services to the community. The loan is collateralized by a 2nd position on the real estate and a first position on equipment and inventory which is located at 6642 West 26th Street. With the existing first mortgage and newly requested funds, the loan to value is a very healthy 64%.

After a review of the company's financials and application packet, the committee recommended approval of the application. The recommended loan amount is not to exceed \$255,000.00 amortized over a 15-year period with a floating interest rate of BDC prime plus 2 with a 12 month introductory interest only rate set at 3%.

The BDC Board concurred with the loan committee recommendation; therefore, seeking final consideration by the Berwyn City Council. If approved, then special legal counsel will draft the needed documents to close the loan at which time the BDC will service the loan.



Re: Revisions to Visitor Parking Passes

Per City ordinance, each household is issued two visitor parking passes, at no cost, with the option of purchasing temporary parking pass booklets at \$5.00 for 15 passes. City staff has concerns that the current usage of visitor parking is not as originally intended and is proposing the following revisions:

- 1. Each household (outside of a 24/7 parking restricted area) will be issued one visitor parking pass in hangtag form.
- Each household located in a superzone parking area or area signed as resident parking only 24 hours a day, 7 days a week will be issued two visitor parking passes in hangtag form, design to be different.
- 3. Households will be able to purchase the temporary parking pass booklets at \$5.00 for 15 passes (no change).

Recommendation

Staff has developed the 3 recommendations above and the attached ordinance for Council approval.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 484.04 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BERWYN, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS REGARDING VISITOR PARKING PASSES

WHEREAS, the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois (the "City") is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs (the "Home Rule Powers"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Berwyn (the "Corporate Authorities") find that the regulation of parking on its streets is a matter pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities recognize the need for visitor parking; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities determine that it is in the best interests of the residents of the City to amend the Codified Ordinances as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its Home Rule Powers, as follows:

Section 1: That the above recitals and legislative findings are incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2: Section 484.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois is hereby amended to read as follows (with proposed additions underlined and proposed deletions stricken):

§ 484.04 VISITOR PARKING PASSES

- (A) Visitor parking passes may be obtained by any city residents. living on any street designated for "Resident Permit Parking Only."
- (B) Passes will be issued and made available at the Parking Division of the City Police Department.
- (C) Each visitor's pass shall be clearly identified as a city visitor parking pass and contain the following information when issued:
 - The address at which it is to be used;
 - A security number;
 - (3) The date upon which it expires.
 - (3) The amount and frequency of the fine for-misuse of the visitor's pass;
- (4) The words: "For Misuse of the Visitor Parking Permit in Violation of Berwyn's Code of Ordinances § 484,04(I);"
- (54) It is advised but not required that the acts of misuse as itemized in § 484.04(I) be listed on the back side of the visitor's parking pass;
- (65) The format of the visitor parking pass shall measure eight and one half inches wide and five and one half inches high be in hangtag form and the color of the visitor parking pass must change for each new year; and
 - (7) The date upon which it expires.
- (D) Residency must be shown by proof of purchase of a current vehicle sticker. If the resident is not a vehicle owner, the Parking Division must require whatever additional identification it deems appropriate to prove city residency.
- (E) The parking pass year shall run from July 1 to June 30. All visitor parking passes shall expire on June 30 of each year and the color of the visitor parking pass must change for each new year to clearly distinguish it from the previous year's parking pass.
- (F) A visitor displaying a valid visitor's pass may park on either side of the street of the block upon which the resident lives and whose address appears on the visitor's pass.
- (G) The visitor pass is to be displayed <u>from the rearview mirror of the vehicle where it</u> may be visible from the exterior of the vehicles. on the dashboard on the passenger's side.

- (H) Each household, outside of a 24 hour 7 day a week parking restricted area or superzone, shall be issued two one visitor passes per parking pass year. Households in areas where parking is restricted to residents only 24 hours a day 7 days a week or superzones, will be issued two annual visitor parking passes. Any household desiring additional visitor parking passes shall obtain parking passes pursuant to § 484.04B of this code.
- (I) Any person who does any of the following shall be fined \$200 per day. A separate offense shall be deemed committed each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues:
- (1) Provides false or misleading information to obtain the issuance of a visitor parking pass;
- (2) Sells, assigns, rents or leases any visitor parking pass, or charges a fee for the use thereof:
 - (3) Duplicates or attempts to duplicate a visitor parking pass;
 - (4) Uses a visitor parking pass not properly issued by the city;
- (5) Uses the visitor parking pass to avoid the purchase of a resident parking permit (vehicle sticker); or
 - (6) Uses the visitor parking pass to avoid having to register a vehicle to a city address.

Section 3. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law. On behalf of the Community Health Assets and Needs Assessment project, we write to solicit a Canvassing and Solicitation permit from the City of Berwyn. As we have shared with you and Mayor Robert J. Lovero, representatives from the organizations listed above are assessing and documenting the health conditions, needs, and resources in Berwyn, Cicero, Garfield Ridge, and Stickney.

The Community Health Assets and Needs Assessment (CHANA) is a community-based, participatory, inductive, and mixed methods project. Among the components of the assessment are building of community profiles, conducting individual and group interviews, and gathering data about the community through community inventories, and a randomized residential survey.

We are soliciting a canvasing and soliciting permit to conduct two components of the project, the community inventories, and the residential survey. We will conduct the community inventories beginning in May through June 2012. We anticipate implementing the residential survey from July through September 2012. Below we describe the components and procedures involved.

Community Inventories

The research partners have designed the community inventory as four modules: city block, medical services, unprepared foods such as grocery stores, and prepared foods such as restaurants. The modules capture information based on observations and interactions with specified personnel. In the appendix to this letter, please find copies of the four modules of the community inventory.

Trained and supervised community surveyors will gather information based on observations in all accessible city blocks in Berwyn. The surveyors will also gather information from interactions with personnel at medical services and food source venues. With authorization from management, surveyors will also observe and record information at unprepared and prepared food venues.

Residential Survey

The residential survey involves a random selection of residences, solicitation of cooperation from occupants at the chosen residences, and completion of a questionnaire. We will use a random selection process to choose 400 residences in Berwyn. The research partners will also select and design the questions included in the survey. Attached please find a draft of the residential survey.

Trained and supervised communities surveyors receive one of the selected residential addresses, will visit the residence and solicit cooperation from the occupants, and collect information on the questionnaire. Participation of residents in the 30 minutes survey is voluntary. We will offer respondents a ten dollars gift certificate to thank them for participating in the survey.

We understand that since the institutions submitting this application are a Charitable Organization and a Non-for-Profit intuition, the City of Berwyn will waive the fee for the application and for the persons that will gather information in the City on behalf of the CHANA project. Alivio Medical Center is register with the State of Illinois as a Charitable Organization.

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

The Community Health Assets and Needs Assessment (CHANA) aims to assess the health conditions, needs, and resources in the City of Berwyn, Town of Cicero, the Chicago community Garfield Ridge and the Village of Stickney. Although the four areas have dramatically changed its demographic composition over the last 20 years, the health conditions, needs, and resources remain largely understudied. The scarcity of information hampers understanding of the health conditions and the development of adequate health interventions.

The CHANA project is a community-based, multi-institutional collaboration and employs a grassroots and inductive approach. Representatives from collaborating institutions make up the Community Advisory Council (CAC), the body that governs the development and implementation of the health assessment. The project employs a grassroots and inductive approaches to ensure that its development remains grounded in the community areas and that the approaches and measurements employed reflect specific community information needs.

The project has six components involving qualitative and quantitative approaches. (1) Reviews of the literature and health information; (2) Focused ethnographic studies; (3) Individual interviews with 48 individual stakeholders; and, (4) 48 groups interviews with community residents. The study also includes: (5) A representative residential survey with 1600 residents; and, (6) community inventories that capture the physical and social shape of the areas, including medical services and prepared as well as unprepared food sources.

The assessment will provide a comprehensive view of the health conditions, necessities, and resources in the four areas. The CHANA assessment will fill current health information gap about the areas, identify health priorities, and inform the development of health interventions. We encourage participation of community residents and organizations. The CAC meets the last Friday of every month to share the information, to plan subsequent segments, and to identify the necessary resources needed to achieve the ensuing goals of the health assessment.
