The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:00 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Skryd, Santoy, Avila and Laureto. Absent: Polashek. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to excuse Alderman Polashek. The motion carried by a voice vote.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was had for the family of Ava Reyna, Granddaughter of Louise Sommese, former Deputy City Clerk, the family of Peter G. Eleutari, WWII Veteran and beloved Grandfather of Detective Michael Fellows and for the Men and Women on the streets of Berwyn protecting our safety, along with the Men and Women in the Armed Forces.
3. The Open Forum portion of the meeting was announced. Berwyn resident Sandi Van Goethem, spoke about two events sponsored by the Berwyn Public Library. Trivia Night Tuesday March 6, 2012, at Garv's-Inn at 6546 Windsor Avenue at 7:00p.m., Book Lovers Club at Olive or twist, Tuesday March 27, 2011 at 7:00p.m., and also spoke about No Longer a 'SHHH!' place, The Berwyn Library moves past stereotypes to offer new programming. The Mayor extended congratulations to Alderman Teddy Polashek, and his wife Misa, on the birth of their son Theodore Jan Polashek, born February 19, 2012.

FEBRUARY 28, 2012**

1. Mayor Lovero called the Committee of the Whole to order at 6:00 p.m., upon the call of the roll, the following responded present. Chapman, Paul, Skryd, Avila, Laureto. Absent: Boyajian, Santoy and Polashek. Avila made a motion, seconded by Skryd, to excuse Boyajian, Santoy and Polashek. The motion carried.

Note: Alderman Boyajian present at 6:01 p.m.

2. Gas tax Increase Presentation: The Mayor recognized Assistant Finance Director Dave Jelonek. Jelonek presented a Power Point Presentation regarding Gas Price Analysis, a study of Gas Prices in Neighboring Communities and sample data from GasBuddy.com of 4-6 surrounding communities with the following Gas Taxes:

Oak Park	.06
Cicero	.02
Berwyn	.01

Compared the average prices, price of gas and the Gas Tax, with no difference in prices vs. Oak Park, which has a .05 higher tax. Also broke down pricing of BP, Shell, Citgo and compared to municipalities with no tax and to those which do have local Gas Tax, with no significant price difference.

Evans Summers gave a presentation on Price Banding, reviewed same and with a recommendation to raise .02 or .03 per gallon. Alderman Avila questioned how much in additional revenue. Answer; approximately \$130,000 with a .01 increase and \$260,000 a year at .02 increase.

Dave Denys explained what price suppliers charge to individual stations and how they can sell to Oak Park 4.5 less then what they charge a station across the street in Berwyn. Alderman Skryd questioned if all revenue goes to MFT fund. Answer; no. Alderman Paul questioned what fund MFT revenues go into. Answer; General Fund.

Note: Alderman Santoy present at 6:16 p.m.

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Staff recommendation is for a .02 or .03 per gallon increase.

3. Utility Fund Presentation: Finance Director John Wysocki explained proposal to replace water/sewer fund. This Utility Fund will included also include Garbage fees, which now go into General Fund. This has to do with the New World system for billing purposes and New World cannot segregate funds, which are on same bill, for accounting purposes. Currently, the Water/Sewer Fund is causing accounting problems with Garbage fees and this will solve the problem for reporting purposes.
4. Budget Presentation: John Wysocki presented a Draft 2012 Budget and gave a power point presentation regarding same (see attached.) Wysocki first thanked all those involved in the Budget process. Presentation included;

\*Changes in City Funds: New Utility Funds, which will now include garbage fees. Senior Program Fund has been eliminated, no changes in service, but it is now accounted as a department of the General Fund.

\*Budget Summary, All Funds: Total city wide revenue are budgeted at \$82.2 million. Expenditures are at \$88.8 Million.

\*General Fund Summary: General Fund revenues are budgeted to decrease by \$750,000 or 2% from 2011. Expenditures are budgeted to decrease by \$1.6 million or 3% from 2011.


\*Property Tax Revenues: the total levy increase of 3% due to the recapture of EAV from the expiring Cermak TIF. The 2011 Levy remained the same as 2010, with no increase.

In summary, the bottom line for the 2012 Budget is an increase of \$697,000 in the General Fund, as planned, to build a reserve fund balance. Wysocki is asking to hold a Public Hearing on March 13, 2012 at 5:45 P.M.

5. There being no further business to come before the Committee of the Whole Meeting, same was after a motion by Santoy, seconded Boyajian, to adjourn the Committee of the Whole at 6:46 p.m. The motion carried.

Dear Mayor and City Council,

The applicants are requesting TIF funds for redevelopment work at their new commercial space. The TIF scope of work includes, but not limited to, demolition, masonry, concrete, doors, bathrooms, water service, signage and office remodeling including electric, HVAC, carpentry and floors. Collision Centers of America is approaching 38 years in business in the Chicago metro area providing auto body services primarily, but in recent years, full service mechanical auto repair and certified towing and recovery also. The new Berwyn location is the 24th unit and will serve the surrounding communities for all collision repair needs from minor dents and fender benders to complete frame repair and paint. 11 jobs are created. The applicant submitted a Tier II TIF application. To this extent, the applicant is requesting TIF funds for redevelopment work at this location in order to fill in the needed gap. Total TIF eligible project costs are expected to be \$317,890.

The application meets the procedural requirements of the Berwyn TIF application which was reviewed by Berwyn Development Corporation (BDC) staff and then processed for consideration. A revenue forecast shows that the business would produce \$358,754 in total tax revenue over the next five years.

The BDC's Board of Directors and the Ogden/Depot TIF committee have both agreed to recommend approval of the below specified TIF monies regarding Collision Centers of America's TIF eligible project costs.

Based on this information, the City Council is being asked to approve TIF monies-to-pay-only-the-eligible-costs-associated-with-this-project up to a maximum of \$65,000 for faced work with the stipulation that no stucco or EIFS be used. As part of our process, BDC staff will validate work



performed and eligibility prior to any payments. Furthermore, the BDC will ensure the applicant will not receive any TIF monies prior to obtaining proper City permits.

With the consent of City Council, Collision Centers of America can commence work on their project and contribute to the revitalization efforts taking place on Ogden Avenue.

**Re: TIF application – Blue Penguin Bar & Grill, 3250 Grove Ave.**

Dear Mayor and City Council,

Applicants are requesting TIF funds for improvements at their new commercial space. The TIF scope of work includes awning, signage and carpeting. The applicant is proposing to renovate the approximately 4,000 sq. ft. commercial space in order to establish his new restaurant. Blue Penguin will be a full service bar and grill featuring pizza and traditional American cuisine with banquet seating on the second floor. The applicants submitted a Tier I TIF application. To this extent, the applicants are requesting TIF funds for redevelopment work at this location in order to fill in the needed gap. Total TIF eligible project costs are expected to be \$7,650.

The application meets the procedural requirements of the Berwyn TIF application which was reviewed by Berwyn Development Corporation (BDC) staff and then processed for consideration. A 5-year revenue forecast shows that the business would produce \$169,076 in total tax revenue.

The BDC's Board of Directors and the Ogden/Depot TIF committee have both agreed to recommend approval of the below specified TIF monies regarding Blue Penguin Bar & Grill's TIF eligible project costs.

Based on this information, the City Council is being asked to approve TIF monies to pay only the eligible costs associated with this project up to a maximum of \$5,490. As part of our process, BDC staff will validate work performed and eligibility prior to any payments. Furthermore, the BDC will ensure the applicant will not receive any TIF monies prior to obtaining proper City permits.

RE: Dog Barking Ordinance

Ladies and Gentlemen,

Although pets can provide much companionship and love, they can also become a nuisance to an entire neighborhood if not cared for properly. Attached is the dog barking ordinance recently passed in Los Angeles, California. A first offense will cost dog owners \$250. A second offense jumps to \$500, and a third offense will result in a \$1,000 fine.

Barking is considered excessive if it continues for 10 minutes or more, or intermittently for 30 minutes or more within a three-hour period.

It would be my recommendation to refer this to the City Attorney for proper drafting as a separate ordinance or to amend to the City of Berwyn Ordinances Chapter 666, or any other appropriate chapter.

ORDINANCE NO. 181930

An ordinance amending Sections 53.18.5 and 53.63 and adding Section 53.34.3 to Article 3, Chapter 5 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to authorize the Department of Animal Services (Department) to conduct barking dog and other hearings in the absence of a dog license, to establish more definite barking dog noise and distance criteria and create a Restricted Dog Permit.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES  
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The title, first unnumbered paragraph and Subsection (a) of Section 53.18.5 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code are amended to read as follows:

**SEC. 53.18.5. HEARING PROCEDURES AND LICENSE REVOCATIONS.**

This section shall govern hearing procedures for barking dog complaints, the revocation of dog licenses and related matters. For purposes of this section the term "dog" includes the plural and the term "owner" means the owner or person having charge, care or custody of a dog.

(a) **Hearing.** A hearing pursuant to this Section shall be held to issue or reissue a dog license upon terms, conditions and restrictions. A hearing shall also be held to revoke a dog license that has previously been issued or reissued upon terms, conditions or restrictions where the owner has either failed to comply with the terms, conditions or restrictions or the violation continues to exist or reoccurs. A hearing also may be held in the absence of a dog license or in the absence of a valid license. Following the hearing, the license may be issued or reissued upon terms, conditions and restrictions, or the owner may be ordered to surrender the dog to the Department or remove the dog from the City as if the license was revoked.

Sec. 2. Paragraph 1 of Subsection (l) of Section 53.18.5 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

1. If, at the initial hearing the Hearing Examiner determines that the allegations are true, the Hearing Examiner shall recommend that the license be issued or reissued upon reasonable terms, conditions or restrictions for the training, handling or maintenance of the dog to abate the condition which gave rise to the hearing. In the absence of a dog license or of a valid license, the Hearing Examiner may recommend that the license be issued upon reasonable terms, conditions or restrictions or if the owner is unwilling to accept an issued or reissued license, that the dog be surrendered to the Department or removed from the City. Surrendering the dog to the Department or removing the dog from the City shall be in addition to any civil or criminal penalties for failure to have a valid license.

Terms, conditions, or restrictions may include but are not limited to the following:

- A. selection of locations within the owner's property or premises where a dog shall not be kept;
- B. requirements as to size, construction or design of an enclosure where a dog may be kept;
- C. specialized training from a trainer or training program approved by the Department to correct any of the dog's behavioral problems;
- D. removal of one or more dogs from the premises to another location or prohibiting the addition of any new dog at the premises;
- E. types and method of restraint, or muzzling, or both;
- F. photo identification, permanent marking, electronic identification device, or all of these, for purposes of identification;
- G. sterilization, even if otherwise exempt;
- H. a civil penalty as provided by ordinance for an administrative citations enforcement program;
- I. requiring the owner to obtain a Restricted Dog Permit with additional terms, conditions and restrictions pursuant thereto.

Sec. 3. Paragraph 3 of Subsection (l) of Section 53.18.5 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

3. If the owner fails to appear at a hearing or absents himself from a hearing, the Hearing Examiner may continue the matter or proceed with the hearing as the Hearing Examiner deems appropriate. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Section, the Hearing Examiner may recommend that the license of any owner who fails to attend a hearing or absents himself from a hearing be revoked if the evidence establishes that the allegations are true. In the absence of a license or a valid license, the Hearing Examiner may recommend that the dog be surrendered to the Department or removed from the City as if the license were revoked. Surrendering the dog to the Department or removing the dog from the City shall be in addition to any civil or criminal penalties for failure to have a valid license.

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Sec. 4. Subsection (n) of Section 53.18.5 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

(n) **Revoked License - Removal of Animal from City.** Following a hearing, if a dog license is revoked, or in the absence of a license or a valid license, if the dog has been ordered to be surrendered to the Department or removed from the City as if the license were revoked, the owner shall surrender the dog to the Department or permanently remove the dog or cause the dog to be permanently removed from the City within five (5) calendar days after either the time for appeal, as provided herein, has passed without an appeal being filed, or the decision of the General Manager revoking a dog license or ordering the dog to be surrendered to the Department or removed from the City as if the license were revoked, has been served upon the dog owner. The dog shall be impounded by the Department if found within the City after the five day period. Failure to remove a dog from the City or surrender it to the Department as provided herein is a misdemeanor.

Sec. 5. Paragraph 1 of Subsection (q) of Section 53.18.5 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

1. The decision of the General Manager to revoke a dog license or order a dog to be surrendered to the Department or removed from the City as if the license were revoked, to declare a dog to be a dangerous animal, to issue or re-issue a dog license upon terms, conditions or restrictions, or refuse to issue a new license pursuant to Subdivision (r) may be appealed to the Board of Commissioners by the owner of the dog as provided herein.

Sec. 6. Section 53.34.3 is added to Article 3 of Chapter V of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to read as follows:

**SEC. 53.34.3. RESTRICTED DOG PERMIT.**

(a) Following a hearing in accordance with Section 53.18.5 or Section 53.34.4, if the Hearing Examiner determines that the bite, attack or injury was the result of improper or negligent training, handling or maintenance, and that the owner or custodian is able and willing to properly train, handle or maintain the dog and that a similar incident is not likely to occur if the terms, conditions and restrictions are followed, the Hearing Examiner may recommend that a Restricted Dog Permit be issued as part of the terms, conditions or restrictions pursuant to Subsection (l) of Section 53.18.5, to include, but not limited to, some or all of the following additional terms, conditions or restrictions to protect the public health, safety and welfare:

1. That in addition to the dog license tax and fee, the owner shall pay a Restricted Dog Permit fee of \$120.00 annually, which is subject to reassessment in accordance with Section 53.12 (a).

2. That the dog owner obtain and maintain liability insurance in an amount not less than \$100,000 or in an amount determined by the City's Risk

Manager, provide proof of insurance and notify the City at least thirty (30) days prior to cancellation or non-renewal of the insurance coverage.

3. Post warning signs at all property entrances and notify the occupants of the adjacent property and/or within a 150 foot radius of the Restricted Dog Permit.

4. That the dog not be transferred or placed in the custody of another person without the written consent of the General Manager, except in a licensed dog kennel or with a California licensed veterinarian. The dog owner must notify any transferee, kennel, veterinarian or other custodian that the dog is subject to a Restricted Dog Permit.

5. Other terms, conditions and restrictions may include but are not limited to the training, handling and maintenance of the dog, the wearing of a muzzle, properly securing the owner's or custodian's property and that the dog only be walked by the owner or another responsible adult.

6. That the dog owner and custodian, if separate from the owner, sign a declaration that he or she will abide by the terms, conditions and restrictions of the license and the Restricted Dog Permit.

(b) A Restricted Dog Permit shall not be issued for a dog that has fatally injured a human being or to a dog owner if any current or previously owned dog of that owner has fatally injured a human being.

(c) A Restricted Dog Permit may be rescinded by the General Manager if the owner demonstrates that measures taken by the owner or changed circumstances have mitigated the danger to the public, including the permanent removal of the dog from the City.

(d) The Department may amend or revoke a Restricted Dog Permit and the dog license following a hearing if the owner has failed to comply with the terms, conditions or restrictions of the Permit or of the dog license.

Sec. 7. The first paragraph and Subsections (a) and (b) of Section 53.63 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code are amended to read as follows:

#### **SEC. 53.63. BARKING DOG NOISE.**

It shall be unlawful for any person to permit any dog or dogs under his or her charge, care, custody or control to emit any excessive noise after the Department has issued a written notice advising the owner or custodian of the alleged noise and the procedures as set forth below have been followed. For purposes of this section, the term "excessive noise" shall mean noise which is unreasonably annoying, disturbing, offensive, or which unreasonably interferes with the comfortable enjoyment of life or

property of one or more persons occupying property in the community or neighborhood, within reasonable proximity to the property where the dog or dogs are kept. The noise must be continuously audible for ten (10) minutes or intermittently audible for thirty (30) minutes within a three (3) hour period. However, the provisions of this section shall not apply to any commercial animal establishment permitted by zoning law where located. The Department is responsible for enforcement of the provisions of this Section as follows:

**(a) First Complaint.**

1. Upon receiving a written complaint involving a whining, barking, howling, or similar dog noise, the Department shall issue a written notice to the owner or person having charge, care, or custody (hereinafter in this Section referred to as the owner) of the dog or dogs advising that person of the noise complaint and requesting immediate abatement of any excessive noise.

2. Complaints to the Department must be submitted in writing, and shall include the name, address and telephone number of the complainant(s) as well as the address of the dog owner and a description of the noise.

**(b) Second Complaint.**


1. If, within 15 days from the issuance of the written notice pursuant to (a) above, a second complaint is received from the complainant along with a written complaint from an additional complainant residing in a separate residence within reasonable proximity to the dog(s), the Department shall, by written notice, require the complainant or complainants and the owner of the dog or dogs to appear at a meeting before a Department representative to discuss possible ways and means to resolve the problem. The Department may proceed with a meeting based on a second complaint from only one complainant if the Department determines that the noise affects that complainant. If the problem remains unresolved, the matter shall be set for hearing as provided by Section 53.18.5.

2. If the owner fails to appear before the Department representative, and there is evidence that the dog or dogs have emitted excessive noise, the problem shall be deemed unresolved, and the matter set for hearing as provided by Section 53.18.5.

Sec. 8. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.



Ladies and Gentlemen:

In January of 2010 the BDC held the 2010 Economic Overview/Strategic Planning Session for the four business corridors within the City of Berwyn. One of the items on the list for implementation for the Cermak Road Corridor was a façade & Signage improvement grant program. BMS worked closely with the BDC to insure that funds from the Cermak TIF were allocated for the façade & Signage improvement grant program. The BDC on February 28, 2010 during a Committee of the Whole meeting included the S.L.A.P program as part of that project list.

In June of that same year BMS presented to the City Council the S.L.A.P initiative, a program that would address Signage, Lighting and Awnings along Cermak Road. BMS worked closely with the BDC to secure \$250,000 in TIF monies to implement the program. BMS also asked the City Council to allow us to administer the program. The City Council approved our request and allowed us to administer this successful program.

I would like to address some misconceptions regarding the \$250,000 and the way it was managed. The successful administration of the S.L.A.P program allowed each qualifying business to be granted up to \$10,000 toward the improvement of their storefronts. The BMS Design Committee met monthly to review the applications and made their recommendations to the BMS board for funding. We successfully funded forty-nine projects, attached you will find the projects completed.

BMS did not charge an administration fee for the S.L.A.P program the funds were strictly used for the businesses. BMS did not receive this money nor was any part of our budget. The total investment amount on Cermak Rd. was \$269,340.00; today we still continue to see private investment improvements along Cermak Rd.

We look forward to continuing our revitalization along on Cermak Rd. and working with the City of Berwyn.

**THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BERWYN,  
COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2012**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois (the "City") is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and, as such, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Codified Ordinances of the City of Berwyn and Section 8-2-9 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-2-9) require the adoption of an ordinance within the first quarter of each fiscal year, to be termed the annual appropriation ordinance, appropriating such sums of money as are deemed necessary to defray all necessary expenses and liabilities of the municipality and which specifies the objects and purposes for which these appropriations are made and the amount appropriated for each object or purpose (the "Annual Appropriation Ordinance"); and

**WHEREAS**, as required by applicable law, notice of a public hearing on the proposed Annual Appropriation Ordinance was published in a newspaper published in the City at least ten (10) days before the time of the public hearing; and

**WHEREAS**, such public hearing was held on March 13, 2012, with all wishing to speak being heard; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with applicable law, City staff prepared a proposed Annual Appropriation Ordinance or a formally prepared appropriation or budget document upon which this Ordinance is based, which has been and is currently conveniently available for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and the City Council have reviewed the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for fiscal year 2012 and have determined that said appropriations are in the best interests of the City and its residents; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Berwyn, County of Cook, State of Illinois, in the exercise of the City's home rule powers, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That the above recitals and legislative findings are incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**SECTION 2:** The following sums of money for each City fund, or as much thereof as may be authorized by law, be and are hereby appropriated for the corporate purposes and objects of the City hereinafter specified for the fiscal year commencing January 1, 2012 and ending on December 31, 2012.



**SECTION 3:** All the appropriations herein made for any purpose shall be regarded only as a maximum amount to be expended under the respective appropriation funds, shall not be construed as a commitment, agreement, obligation or liability of the City, and each such appropriation being subject to further approval as to the actual expenditure thereof by the Mayor and City Council of the City.

**SECTION 4:** To the extent allowed by applicable law, any unexpended balance of the appropriations for the fiscal years prior hereto are hereby specifically re-appropriated for the same fund purposes for which they were originally made and may be expended in making up any insufficiency in any item or items provided in this Ordinance without supplemental appropriation.

**SECTION 5:** The sums as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, or so much thereof as may be authorized by law and needed or deemed necessary, are hereby appropriated to defray and pay all necessary expenses and liabilities of the City and such appropriations are hereby made for the objects and purposes as set forth in Exhibit A.

**SECTION 6:** The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form or in a newspaper of general circulation within the City within thirty (30) days after its adoption. The City Clerk is further authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Cook County Clerk within thirty (30) days of its adoption and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the City is authorized to certify to the Cook County Clerk that the Estimate of Revenues by Source, incorporated herein by reference, is a true statement of said revenues, which Estimate of Revenues by Source shall also be filed with the Cook County Clerk within said thirty (30) day period. The officers, employees and/or agents of the City shall take all actions necessary or reasonably required to carry out, give effect to and consummate the intent of this Ordinance and shall take all actions in conformity therewith. The officers, employees and/or agents of the City are specifically authorized and directed to draft and disseminate any and all necessary forms to be utilized in connection with the terms and purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 7:** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 8:** All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 9:** Any non-preemptive state statute in conflict hereof with this Ordinance is hereby superseded to the full extent of such conflict pursuant to the exercise of the home rule powers of the City.

---

**SECTION 10:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

### **Re: Berwyn Emergency Management Update**

Mayor and Members of the City Council:

In 2007, Berwyn City Council adopted a resolution establishing a National Incident Management System (NIMS). NIMS is a nationally recognized method designed with the purpose of allowing shared decision making between first responders and stakeholders during a disaster.

Since the enactment of NIMS in Berwyn, the City's disaster preparedness has greatly increased. An Emergency Action Plan has been adopted and is pending approval from Cook County and the IEMA, NIMS training is underway, Berwyn has hosted Department of Homeland Security Training and we are currently in the process of setting up CERT and MRT programs.

Going forward, there are several goals that we are working towards to further improve our emergency preparedness. Currently, the priority is to update NIMS CAST, the online management and reporting application for NIMS. By bringing NIMS CAST up-to-date we will ensure that we continue to have access to federal grant dollars. Updating NIMS CAST will also allow us to develop an essential facilities plan review program.

Finally, Berwyn Emergency Management has plans to create public information programs, maintain Berwyn's Emergency Operations Center and combine the services of Berwyn Emergency Management Agency (BEMA) and Berwyn Emergency Services (BES).

It is important to know that Berwyn is prepared for whatever may come.
