

MINUTES BERWYN CITY COUNCIL May 10, 2011

- The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:05 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Boyajian, Paul, Santoy, Polashek, Avila, Laureto. Absent: Chapman, Skryd. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Polashek, to excuse Alderman Chapman and Alderman Skryd. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was observed for the men and women in the armed forces especially in light of the recent events in the Middle East and for the men and women on the streets of Berwyn protecting our safety.
- 3. The Open Forum portion of the meeting was announced. The Mayor recognized resident, David Olson, president of the Berwyn Historical Society who spoke on the purchase of a building on the south east corner of 14th and Grove Ave. to house the Berwyn Historical Society and wanted to thank the Mayor and Alderman Laureto for their assistance in this matter. Alderman Laureto welcomed the Berwyn Historical Society to the 8th ward. The Mayor spoke regarding FEMA's reimbursement in the amount of approximately \$195,000 which was reimbursed for the snow emergency this past winter.
- 4. The minutes of the Berwyn City Council Meeting, held April 26, 2011 and the Committee of the Whole, held on April 26, 2011 were submitted. Thereafter Boyajian, made a motion, seconded by Laureto, to concur and approve as submitted. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 5. A motion by Boyajian, seconded by Avila, to suspend the rules and bring forth item J-8. The Motion carried by a voice vote. Item J-8 is a communication from Berwyn's Fire Chief Dennis O' Halloran regarding the swearing in of New Probationary Firefighter's/Paramedics. Clerk Pavlik administrated the oath of office to Frank Bonadonna, Christina Jacobs, Dan Ploskonka, Marc Woltzen, Brandon Keag, Leon Botha, Douglas Zimmer, Brendan O'Brien, Joseph Kurtz, Joseph Petrancosta, Matthew Maty, Adrian Contreras, Dominick Licato and Richard Chaput, Jr. Thereafter, Avila, made a motion seconded, by Polashek to concur and approve as submitted. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
- 6. A deferred communication from the Berwyn Development Corporation, regarding Land Swap Agreement with the North Berwyn Park District with a Resolution attached entitled:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE AND EXCHANGE OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY WITH THE NORTH BERWYN PARK DISTRICT AND THE EXECUTION OF A CERTAIN AGREEMENT.

Thereafter, a motion by Avila, seconded by Santoy to concur and **adopt** the Resolution as presented and to authorize the corporate authorities to affix their signatures thereto. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote. Thereafter, a motion by Avila, seconded by Polashek, to concur and **adopt** the Ordinance as presented and to authorize the corporate authorities to affix their signatures thereto. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

- 7. The Berwyn Development Corporation submitted a communication regarding the Cermak (Theater) TIF. District, Phase II Infrastructure Improvements. The Mayor recognized Anthony Griffin Executive Director of the Berwyn Development Corporation who reviewed same. Thereafter, a motion by Avila, seconded by Boyajian, to concur and approve as submitted. Motion carried by following roll call, Yeas: Boyajian, Santoy, Polashek, Avila, Laureto. Nays: Paul. Absent: Chapman, Skryd.
- 8. The Berwyn Development Corporation submitted a communication regarding a TIF application-Padgett Business Service, 6828 Windsor Ave. The Mayor recognized Anthony Griffin of the Berwyn Development Corporation who reviewed same. Thereafter, a motion by Avila, seconded by Laureto to concur and approve as submitted for payment in an amount not to exceed \$2,000 plus 80% of city permits. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
- 9. The City Clerk submitted a communication regarding approval of Closed COW Minutes of January25, 2011, February 8, 2011, February 22, 2011 March 8, 2011, March 16, 2011, and April 12, 2011 as reviewed in closed session on April 26, 2011. Thereafter, a motion by Laureto, seconded by Avila, to concur and approved as submitted. Motion carried by a voice vote.
- 10. The Berwyn Historic Preservation Commission submitted a communication regarding withdrawing the pending nomination of Marik Funeral Home as a Local Landmark. Thereafter, a motion by Laureto, seconded by Santoy to accept as informational. Motion carried by a voice vote.
- 11. The Building/Zoning/Planning Committee held a meeting on April 25, 2011 regarding referral item #7 dated March 22, 2011 Signage/Roosevelt Road, with a recommendation that any new signage along Roosevelt Road corridor be referred to the Roosevelt Road Business Association for review prior to permit application

- to the Building Dept. Thereafter, a motion by Laureto, seconded by Santoy to accept the matter as informational. Motion carried by a voice vote.
- 12. The Parking and Traffic Committee submitted a communication regarding a meeting held on May 5, 2011 regarding the revisions of ordinance 484.05 and 484.055 pertaining to handicap parking, with the recommendation the revisions to the ordinance be referred from the committee to the Legal Department for comment and review. Thereafter, a motion by Paul, seconded by Boyajlan to accept the matter as informational. Motion carried by a voice vote.
- 13. The City Administrator submitted a communication regarding recommendation to hire an architect for the library elevator design only. Thereafter, a motion by Laureto, seconded by Polashek, to concur and approved as submitted. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
- 14. The City Administrator submitted a communication regarding approval for staff to develop and disseminate RFP's via our sealed bid process for both an elevator and a general contractor. Thereafter, a motion by Boyajian, seconded by Laureto to concur and approve as submitted. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 15. The City Administrator submitted a communication regarding Berwyn Insurance Renewal for Property, Auto Physical Damage and Fire Fiduciary. Thereafter, a motion by Laureto, seconded by Polashek to concur and approve insurance for Auto Physical Damage and Property with One Beacon in the amount of \$140,159. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote. Thereafter, a motion by Laureto, seconded by Polashek, to concur and approve insurance for Fiduciary Liability with Ullico in the amount of \$3,849. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

Berwyn City Council COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE May 10, 2011

- The Committee of the Whole was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 6:00 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Boyajian, Paul, Polashek, Avila, Laureto. Absent: Chapman, Skryd, Santoy. Thereafter, a motion by Avila, seconded by Boyajian to excuse Alderman Chapman, Alderman Skryd, Alderman Santoy. Motion carried.
- 2. Insurance renewals the Mayor recognized City Administrator Brian Pabst and a representative from Mesirow Insurance regarding communication J-3. Pabst reviewed and noted that a numbered was transposed so the total amount was \$140,159 not \$140,149. The Mayor questioned if there are any savings over lasts years policy that we had with Hartford. Answer, yes over \$40,000 in savings and the coverage meets or exceeds lasts years policies. Note: Alderman Santoy resent at 6:10 p.m.
 Thereafter, the Mayor asked for a concurrence on the communication and the need for two motions to be made for Item J-3.
- 3. Library Elevator Project. The Mayor once again recognized Administrator Brian Pabst and representative Ed Kalina, regarding item J-2, with the recommendation to hire inter-Plan, LLC and also summarized the process and a recommendation to retain to plan for structural design, to go out for bid for an elevator contractor and general contractor, per communication J-2. Ed Kalina was available for any questions, there were none.
- 4. Phase II Cermak Infrastructure improvements. The Mayor recognized Anthony Griffin from the BDC, City Engineer John Fitzgerald and Public Works Director Robert Schiller. Anthony Griffin reviewed the safely and Infrastructure project, item E-2 on the council agenda and also noted a handout from the Berwyn Police Dept. regarding the Vacin Fairway (see attached,) with crime statistics and analysis. Griffin reviewed, along with strategic landscaping plan. Alderman Santov questioned the priority of Phase II, III and IV and questioned if there would be any available funds for any business applications before the end of the TIF. Griffin stated there is limited funding available for Tier I and Tier II TIF applications projects and that \$150,000 has been ear marked for the new national tenant for the Craig Shoes site. Alderman Avila, questioned lighting. Engineer Fitzgerald explained replacement is necessary, the lighting is at the end of their life cycle. Avila questioned the age of the lights. Fitzgerald answered, approximately 37 plus years, but that they will be able to salvage and to use for spare parts. Alderman Paul, questioned if all these safely and liability issues have been taken care of. Griffin answered yes, expect for the Hand Holes on the street

lights. Once again, Engineer John Fitzgerald explained the need and the decision to replace the light poles vs. resurfacing or powder coating. Alderman Polashek questioned replacing or repairing the damage to the flower median planters and if this was included in this project. Answer, yes. Alderman Paul guestioned when the TIF expires. Answer, July 2010, but we can recoup the 24th year of tax and have until December 31, 2011 to spend the funds. Alderman Paul questioned use of funds for Berwyn Gardens and if Berwyn Gardens will be included in the new proposed TIF area. Answer, yes. Alderman Paul questioned why spend the money on Berwyn Gardens now when they can gather funds from the new TIF and/or use funds from the SLAP program through Main Street. Also questioned the recommendations on item E-2 and whether the council can vote on them separately. Griffin answered; they were presented as a package. Alderman Boyajian questioned the use of LED Lighting. Fitzgerald answered, no, IDOT has not approved the use of LED lighting anywhere to date and this may take up to 3 years. Boyajian also questioned how the funds would be spent by NBPD. The Mayor than recognized Joe Vallez, Exc. Director of the North Berwyn Park District, who presented the NBPD plans for the Berwyn Gardens area and how they're relocation the play ground and the infrastructure, including water, lighting, electrical and sidewalks. Boyajian questioned the pools and if the city will be running them this summer, answer yes. The Mayor went on to explain the need for the city to secure this potion of Berwyn Garden's to secure the national tenant. Discussion ensued regarding the DNR (Dept. of National Resources) approval, Vallez stated, based on the conversion with them, he is confident that they will approve. Council questioned the use of the 400,000 and if the NBPD has to use these funds for the Berwyn Gardens, answer yes, the funds have to be spent within the TIF area. Council questioned the time frame for NBPD completion of their relocation project. Answer, approximately 6 months.

5. The Mayor recognized residents Gil Pena and Rick Toman who have approached the city for the display of American Flags in designated areas during the weeks prior to Memorial Day, through the week after Labor Day (see attached proposal.) They are seeking consent from the council to move forward with their project for fundraising, noting this will be at no cost to the city and done by a volunteer committee. Also, they would need to coordinate with Public Works for installation. Mayor recognized Public Works Director Robert Schiller who stated, the city should be able to accommodate. Alderman Boyajlan suggested contacting and Informing the Berwyn Park District of the project and seek the use of its lift truck, which the city has accessed use, in the past, through an intergovernmental agreement. The Mayor then asked for consensus to allow them to move forward with their fundraising project. Consensus, 6-0 in flavor.

- 6. A motion by Boyajian, seconded by Polashek, to close the Committee of the Whole at 7:07 p.m. for pending litigation, and acquisition. Motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

- 8. A motion by Avila, seconded by Boyajian to adjourn the Committee of the Whole at 7:53 p.m. Motion carried by a voice vote.
