

### MINUTES BERWYN CITY COUNCIL MARCH 8, 2011

- The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:02.p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Boyajian, Paul, Skryd, Santoy, Polashek, Avila, Laureto. Absent: Chapman. Thereafter, Boyajian made a motion, seconded by Polashek, to excuse Alderman Chapman. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was observed for the deceased Richard Fenhouse, Sr. Father-in Law of Police Officer, Mark Schwanderlik, and returning soldier Sergeant Kenneth Marinellie who was welcomed home this weekend by the Combined Veterans of Berwyn, for the men and women on the streets of Berwyn and for the armed forces protecting our safety.
- 3. The Open Forum portion of the meeting was announced. A resident of Berwyn and a representative of Youth Crossroads spoke regarding the Youth Leadership Program and the Lakota Sioux Service trip in an effort to have the Youth Service Leadership volunteers attend this year, Alderman Laureto also encouraged all to donate by calling Youth Crossroads at 708-484-7400, Alderman Polashek reminded all that this Saturday at 6:30 the Sokol Tabor will hold their Exhibition Night, Alderman Laureto also reminded all of the Youth Crossroads Vegas Night this Friday at the Skylite West and also of the District 98 Education Foundation Dinner Dance this Saturday.
- 4. The minutes of the regular Berwyn City Council meeting, the Committee of the Whole, and the Public Hearing for the Appropriation Ordinance for February 22, 2011 were submitted. Thereafter, Skryd, made a motion, seconded by Paul, to concur and approve as submitted. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 5. Boyajian made a motion, seconded by Paul, to suspend the rules and bring forth items I-3 and J-4. The motion carried by a voice vote. Item I-3 is a Resolution from the Berwyn Historic Preservation Commission regarding the Nomination of the World War I Memorial as a Berwyn Historic Landmark. Thereafter, Skryd made a motion,

seconded by Boyajian, to concur with the recommendation and refer to the Law Department to draft an ordinance to enact same. The motion carried by a voice vote.

6. The City Attorney submitted a communication along with an attached Resolution regarding "Nesladek Way" entitled:

A Resolution regarding the Honorary Designation of a portion of East Avenue from Ogden Avenue to the First North Alley-Way as "Nesladek Way"

Thereafter, Boyajian made a motion, seconded by Skryd, to concur and **adopt** the Resolution as presented and to authorize the corporate authorities to affix their signatures thereto. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

- 7. The Berwyn Development Corporation submitted a TIF application for Dunkin Donuts/Baskins Robbins, 6601 W. Cermak Road. The Mayor recognized Anthony Griffin of the Berwyn Development Corporation who reviewed same. Thereafter, Skryd made a motion, seconded by Polashek, to concur and approve as submitted in an amount up to \$55,000 plus 50% of cost associated with improvements to the parking and drive thru. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
- The Berwyn Development Corporation submitted a communication regarding the Model Communities Grant. Thereafter, Skryd made a motion, seconded by Avila, to concur and authorize the Mayor to sign the attached agreement. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
- 9. The Parking and Traffic Committee submitted a communication regarding various committee agenda items including Harvey-Highland, Cuyler Streets conversions and Paisan's Traffic, Proposed Parking, Shared Program for area churches and Referrals Items with the recommendation that the matters be accepted as informational. Thereafter, Paul made a motion, seconded by Skryd, to accept as informational. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 10. The Parking and Traffic Committee submitted a communication referencing referral item #25 dated September 28, 2010 regarding School District Visitor Parking Pass. Thereafter, Paul made a motion, seconded by Skryd, to refer the matter to the Law Department for review and draft of amendments to ordinance 484.04A. The motion carried by a voice vote.

11. A deferred communication from the City Attorney and the Traffic Engineer along with an ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 480.05 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BERWYN, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS REGARDING STREET CLEANING AND SNOW EMERGENCY PARKING RESTRICTIONS.

Thereafter, Paul made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to concur and **adopt** the ordinance as presented and to authorize the corporate authorities to affix their signatures thereto. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

12. A deferred communication from the City Attorney and the Traffic Engineer along with an ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 480.07 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BERWYN, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS REGARDING LIMITED PARKING

Thereafter, Paul made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to concur and **adopt** the ordinance as presented and to authorize the corporate authorities to affix their signatures thereto. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

13. A deferred communication from the City Attorney and the Traffic Engineer along with an ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 484.03 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BERWYN, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS REGARDING DEPOT AND BUSINESS RESERVED PERMIT PARKING

Thereafter, Paul made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to concur and **adopt** the ordinances as presented and to authorize the corporate authorities to affix their signatures thereto. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

- 14. The Library Director submitted a communication requesting replacement of two (2) Pages (13-15 hrs.). Thereafter, Skryd made a motion, seconded by Avila, to concur, waive the hiring freeze and approve as submitted. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
- 15. The Public Works Director submitted a communication recommending the disposal of one (1) 1989 Ford L8000 Dump Truck assigned to the Public Works Department. Thereafter, Boyajian made a motion, seconded by Skryd, to concur and refer the matter to the Finance Director to declare surplus. The motion carried by a voice vote.

- 16. The Public Works Director submitted a communication regarding a recommendation to approve the purchase of a State Bid Dump Truck in an amount not to exceed \$106,160. Thereafter, Boyajian made a motion, seconded by Paul, to concur. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
- 17. The Public Works Director submitted a communication regarding the recommendation to award the bid replacement of the Master Meter Vault regarding the transmission of water to Berwyn from Chicago. Thereafter, Boyajian made a motion, seconded by Avila, to concur and approve as submitted and to award the contract to Cerniglia Construction Co. in the amount of \$164,200. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote
- 18. The Public Works Director submitted a communication regarding the 2011 Landscape Maintenance request to extend contracts. Thereafter, Boyajian made a motion, seconded by Skryd, to concur and approve as amended on face to the extension of the Ogden Avenue Landscape Maintenance to Brancato Landscaping in the amount of \$14,825, to Brian Davids Landscaping for the Depot District in the amount of \$15,720 and the Cermak Road area at a cost of \$19,545. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
- 19. The Public Works Director submitted a communication regarding the recommendation to approve the purchase of a Bobcat 750 from State Bid in the amount not to exceed \$47,767. Thereafter, Boyajian made a motion, seconded by Skryd to concur and approve as submitted. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
- 20. Consent Agenda-K-1 through K-7 were submitted. K-1-Budget Chairman, payroll for March 2, 2011, \$973,203.49 K-2-Budget Chairman, payables for March 22, 2011, \$1,312,762.08 K-3-Building Director, building permits issued in February, 2011 K-4-Boyajian, handicap sign, V. Campos, 3308 Harvey, Deny K-5-Boyajian, handicap sign, Y. Garcia, 3032 Clarence, Approve K-6-St. Odilo Church, St. Joseph Day Procession, March 19, 2011 K-7-Combined Veterans of Berwyn, 2011 special ceremonies Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Polashek, to concur and approve by Omnibus Vote Designation. The motion carried by a voice vote.

- Alderman Boyajian called a committee meeting for the Ad Hoc Committee on Hazardous Waste for Monday, March 21, 2011 at 5:30 p.m., as previously called.
- 22. Alderman Skryd announced an Administration Committee meeting, as previously called for Monday, March 21, 2011 at 5:00 p.m.
- 23. Alderman Santoy rescheduled a previously called meeting of the Business License and Taxation Committee for Tuesday, March 22, 2011 at 5:00 p.m.
- 24. The Mayor called a Special Committee of the Whole meeting for Wednesday, March 16, 2011 at 6:00 p.m., Closed to the Public, with the Berwyn Historic Preservation Committee invited to attend.
- 25. There being no further business to come before the meeting, same was, after a motion by Laureto, seconded by Skryd, to adjourn at the hour of 8:31 p.m. The motion carried by a voice vote.

# COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MARCH 8, 2011

- The Committee of the Whole was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 6:03 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Boyajian, Paul, Skryd, Polashek, Avlla, Laureto. Absent: Chapman, Santoy.
- Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Boyajlan, to excuse Aldermen Chapman and Santoy. The Mayor informed the Council that Alderman Chapman did give notice that she would be late, but would try to make the meeting.
- The Mayor recognized Traffic Engineer, Nicole Campbell regarding Directional Redistributing Presentation for Harvey, Highland, Cuyler from Pershing to Ogden Avenue and presented a power point presentation, see attached, which included current conditions
  - Ogden Avenue to 39<sup>th</sup> Street with Cuyler Avenue being one-way southbound
  - Highland Avenue, one-way northbound, Harvey one-way southbound, and
  - Lombard Avenue one-way southbound, leaving 3 southbound verses 1 northbound street for the area grid.

Campbell gave a history regarding traffic study on Lombard Avenue that started in January 2010, which resulted in the recommendation to divert Lombard to one-way southbound, which then left an uneven directional distribution on adjacent 3 streets. Lombard was converted in August 2010.

Observed Traffic changes after August 2010 where traffic volumes had

- Decreased on Harvey
- Increased on Highland and Cuyler Avenue and
- Highland Avenue had experienced the greatest increase and change at 36%

### as of February 23, 2011:

- 3400 block of Harvey experienced 378 vehicles a day
- 3400 block of Highland experienced 859 a day
- 3400 block of Cuyler experienced 662 a day

### Thereafter, Campbell gave the proposal for making

- Cuyler Avenue a one-way northbound, Highland one-way southbound,
- · Harvey one-way northbound,
- · Lombard one-way southbound.

Thereafter, a series of questions and concerns were raised from the aldermen including how soon before the changes can go into effect. Campbell answered, possibly as soon as May. Discussion ensued on having Lombard Avenue two-way until Cicero alley to help with potential increase in traffic from Palsan's Pizza parking lot.

Santoy present at 6:25 p.m

- 4. Model Communities Grant-The Mayor once again recognized Nicole Campbell and Kurtis Pozsgay of the Berwyn Development Corporation regarding item E-2 on the Council agenda, noting that the city was awarded \$140,000 to promote health with 4 Main Parts
  - Non motorized Travel
  - Safe Park Zone
  - School Travel Plan
  - Active Transportation

They are looking at the city as a whole regarding

- Pedestrian traffic,
- Biking safety
- Safe Park Zones
- Complete Street policy

all of which will open up to other grant opportunities for the future.

- 5. The Mayor asked for a motion to go into closed for pending litigation, land acquisition, and real estate. Thereafter, Skryd made a motion, seconded by Polashek, to closed the Committee of the Whole at 6:30 p.m. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 6. Avila made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to reopen the Committee of the Whole at 7:50 p.m. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 7. Santoy made a motion, seconded by Skryd, to adjourn the Committee of the Whole at 7:50 p.m.



RE: Signage/Roosevelt Road

Dear Mayor and Member of the City Council:

It has been brought to my attention that there is signage on the buildings on Roosevelt Road that are not within the City ordinance. Several of the businesses on Roosevelt Road have signage on the brick indicating their names and/or type of business. I have discussed this issue with the Building Director, Mr. Chuck Lazzara and the Roosevelt Road Businessman Association (RRBA) President, Mr. Paul Zimmerman. Because these signs are easy to spot as you drive down Roosevelt it is the feelings of the RRBA that these signs are of benefit to the businesses and the residents, making the buildings which do not have signage over the sidewalk easy to spot. The Oak Park side of Roosevelt also has such signage. Since we are embarking on a new Roosevelt Streetscape look, I would ask that we allow the signage that is now in place to be approved pending the approval of the RRBA and the Building Department. I would also ask that any further signage be must approved by the RRBA prior to being allowed their application by the Building Department. Mr. Zimmerman stated that the RRBA would take on this task and report to the Building Department in a timely manner.

I would therefore ask that this request be referred to the Legal Department for drafting of the ordinance and that Mr. Paul Zimmerman and the Building Department be notified of this change upon approval of the ordinance.

Gunderson Avenue, at the intersection of 34<sup>th</sup> Street, Ogden Avenue, and Ridgeland Avenue, Berwyn, Illinois as a Historic Landmark; and

WHEREAS, the Commission unanimously recommended to the City Council on March 9, 2011 that the World War I Memorial at 3401 S. Gunderson Avenue, at the intersection of 34<sup>th</sup> Street, Ogden Avenue, and Ridgeland Avenue, Berwyn, Illinois embodies significant historical, cultural, architectural, and aesthetic value as part of the heritage of the City of Berwyn, the State of Illinois, and the United States.

**SECTION 2**: **Adoption.** The World War I Memorial at 3401 S. Gunderson Avenue, at the intersection of 34<sup>th</sup> Street, Ogden Avenue, and Ridgeland Avenue, Berwyn, Illinois shall hereafter be designated as a Historic Landmark pursuant to the Historic Preservation Ordinance, and subject to the provisions therein.

**SECTION 3.** Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file with the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois a certified copy of this designation ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 6.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois (the "City") is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs (the "Home Rule Powers"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Berwyn (the "Corporate Authorities") has adopted a Traffic Code, which has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have further decided to enact the traffic regulations identified herein along Cuyler Avenue, Highland Avenue and Harvey Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities determine that it is in the best interests of the residents of the City to amend the Codified Ordinances as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its Home Rule Powers, as follows:

**Section 1**: That the above recitals and legislative findings are incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2:** Section 460.10(w)(x)(y) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois is hereby amended to read as follows (with proposed additions **underlined** and proposed deletions stricken):

### 460.10 ONE-WAY STREETS DESIGNATED

Whenever authorized one-way street signs have been erected on any street, it shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to proceed along such street in a direction otherwise than indicated by such signs.

The following streets and parts of streets within the city are hereby designated as one-way traffic streets traveling in the direction indicated:

### (w) Cuyler Avenue

- Northbound; Roosevelt Road to 29<sup>th</sup> Street, Ogden Avenue to Pershing Road.
- (2) Southbound; Park Avenue to the alley north of Ogden Avenue, Ogden Avenue to Pershing Road.
- (x) Highland Avenue
  - (1) Southbound; 13th Street to 29th Street, Ogden Avenue to Pershing Road.
  - (2) Northbound; Ogden Avenue to Pershing Road.
- (y) Harvey Avenue
  - Northbound; Roosevelt Road to 29<sup>th</sup> Street, Ogden Avenue to Pershing Road.
  - (2) Southbound; Ogden Avenue to Pershing Read.
- (z) Lombard Avenue
  - (1) Southbound; Roosevelt Road to 26<sup>th</sup> Street, (Lombard Avenue from 26<sup>th</sup> Street to the alley south of 26<sup>th</sup> Street shall remain a two-way street), the alley south of 26<sup>th</sup> Street to 29<sup>th</sup> Street and Ogden Avenue to Pershing Road.

A parking study was conducted on the 2100 block of Clarence Avenue after receiving a petition from the residents of that block. The study indicated 55% of vehicles parked on the block are non-residents. These vehicles are also parked for an 8 hour or longer period. This study is representative of the parking situation of the surrounding blocks. The parking study was then expanded to areas south of Cermak Road without daytime residential parking restrictions. The parking on 23<sup>rd</sup> Street between East and Scoville Avenues was examined. 100% of the vehicles parked were non-resident vehicles for an 8 hour or greater period.

#### Recommendations

It is my recommendation to sign the 1900 and 2100 blocks, up to the Vacin Fairway, of Wesley, Clarence, East and Scoville Avenues and 19th and 21st Streets as Resident Parking 8am-5pm Monday through Saturday. It is also my recommendation to sign 23th Street from Euclid to Gunderson Avenues and the 2300 block of Wesley Avenue Resident Parking 8am-5pm Monday through Saturday. This will include the parking study area on 23th Street and areas previously signed as Resident Parking 8am-3:30pm, into one uniform parking restriction. The ordinances facilitating these changes will be approved and presented to Council.

**Section 2:** Section 484.08A of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois is hereby amended to read as follows (with proposed additions <u>underlined</u> and proposed deletions <u>stricken</u>):

#### 484.08A RESIDENT PARKING ONLY

- (a) Limitations in addition to Section 484.08 shall be established by ordinance. The locations which are the subject of such additional restrictions shall be clearly marked with signage indicating the days and times.
  - 1) RESIDENT PARKING ONLY 8:00 A.M. TO 10:00 A.M. MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY

These locations are as follows:

Stanley Avenue from Maple Avenue to Clinton Avenue and from Euclid Avenue to Wesley Avenue.

Maple, Wisconsin, Wenonah and Home Avenues from Stanley Avenue to 31st Street.

Maple, Wisconsin and Wenonah Avenues from 34th to 35th Streets.

West side of Home Avenue from Windsor Avenue to 35th Street. East side of Home Avenue from the alley south of Windsor Avenue to 35th Street.

West side of Clinton Avenue from 31st Street to Stanley Avenue and from Windsor Avenue to 35th Street. East side of Clinton Avenue from 31st Street to the alley north of Stanley Avenue and from the alley south of Windsor Avenue to 35th Street.

Kenilworth Avenue from the alley north of Stanley Avenue to the alley south of 31st Street.

Wesley, Clarence, East and Scoville Avenues from Stanley Avenue to 31st Street.

East side of Gunderson Avenue from Stanley Avenue to 31st Street. West side of Gunderson Avenue from the alley north of Stanley Avenue to 31st Street. Gunderson from the first alley south of Windsor to 34th Street.

North side of 31st Street from Maple Avenue to Scoville Avenue. South side of 31st Street from Harlem Avenue to Clinton Avenue and from the alley east of Kenilworth Avenue to Oak Park Avenue and from the alley east of Oak Park Avenue to Gunderson Avenue.

North side of 32nd Street from the first alley east of Harlem Avenue to Grove Avenue. South side of 32nd Street from the first alley east of Harlem Avenue to the alley east of Kenilworth Avenue. 32nd Street from Gunderson Avenue to Lombard Avenue.

34th Street from Harlem Avenue to Grove Avenue.



# AN ORDINANCE REPLACING SCHOOL DISTRICT, CHURCH, DAYCARE AND CITY EMPLOYEE PARKING AND AMENDING CHAPTER 484 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BERWYN

WHEREAS, the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois (the "City") is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs (the "Home Rule Powers"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Berwyn (the "Corporate Authorities") has adopted a Traffic Code, which has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities recognize the need for employee parking for the School Districts, churches, daycares and city service providers within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities determine that it is in the best interests of the residents of the City to amend the Codified Ordinances as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its Home Rule Powers, as follows:

**Section 1:** That the above recitals and legislative findings are incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2:** Section 484.04A of the Codified Ordinances is hereby stricken in its entirety and replaced with the following:

# 484.04A SCHOOL DISTRICT, CHURCH, DAYCARE AND CITY EMPLOYEE PARKING.

- (A) Parking Permits may be made available to staff members of School Districts 98 and 100, and churches and daycares registered with the City.
- (B) School, Church or Daycare Parking Permits may be applied for and issued at the Parking Division located in the Police Department.
- (C) Applications for such permits shall include the name, address, telephone number, vehicle information of the applicant and any other such information required by the Parking Division.
- (D) School, Church or Daycare Parking Permits shall be in hangtag form and in colors designated by the Parking Division, shall be numbered and shall state the date of issuance and date of expiration. Such permits shall be displayed from the rearview mirror of the vehicle where they may be visible from the exterior of the vehicles.
- (E) The fee for a School, Church or Daycare Parking Permit shall be \$10.00 a permit per year.
- (F) A school, church or daycare parking permit (parking permit) shall allow the nonresident staff member to park on either side of the street within a one block radius of the institution and allow a resident or non-resident staff member to park within City owned areas designated as staff parking for that institution.
- (G) Parking permits do not supercede parking regulations established by City ordinance or State statute.
- (H) Resident staff members applying for a parking permit must have proof of a valid vehicle sticker.
- (I) Any person or institution who does any of the following shall be fined in accordance with § 484.99. A separate offense shall be deemed committed each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues:
  - (1) Provides false or misleading information to obtain the issuance of a parking permit;
  - Sells, assigns, rents or leases any parking permit, or charges a fee for the use thereof;
  - (3) Duplicates or attempts to duplicate a parking permit;
  - (4) Uses a parking permit not properly issued by the city;
  - (5) Uses a parking permit to avoid the purchase of a resident parking permit (vehicle sticker).

- (J) All parking permits shall expire on July 30 of the year in which they were issued and the color of the parking permit must be changed for each new year.
- (K) The City reserves the right to revise or revoke parking privileges and limit the number of permits sold.
- (L) The following areas shall be designated as school staff parking between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. These areas shall be signed accordingly and vehicles using these spaces will require permits as described herein.
  - (1) East side of Wisconsin Avenue from 16th Street north to the alley.
  - (2) West side of Wenonah Avenue from the cul-de-sac north of 16th Street north to the alley.
  - (3) East side of Clinton Avenue from 35th Street south to the school's southern boundary line.
