

# MINUTES BERWYN CITY COUNCIL JULY 26, 2011

- The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor Lovero at 8:00 P.M. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Skryd, Santoy, Avila, Laureto, Absent: Polashek. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Boyajian, to excuse Alderman Polashek. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence was observed for the deceased Clara Richards, Grandmother-in-law of Berwyn Police Detective Sergeant Michael Cirolia, deceased of William "Bill" Harrison, Father-in-law Deputy Fire Chief Gregory Dimenna, the deceased Phillip Folkers, Husband of Berwyn Police Department Telecommunications Office Carol Folkers, deceased Elizabeth Kubkowski, Mother-in-law of Police Officer Daniel Dimenna, deceased Antoinette Murawski, Grandmother of Berwyn Police Department Records Clerk Bridgette Szarfinski and for the Men and Women on the streets of Berwyn protecting our safely along with the Men and Women in the Armed Forces.
- The Open Forum portion of the meeting was announced. The Mayor recognized 2<sup>nd</sup> Ward Alderman Boyajian who invited all to attend the Take Back the Night Rally for National Night Out to be held at Proska Park on Tuesday July 27th, Mayor Lovero spoke regarding the Berwyn's Minor Girls Baseball who has won their sectional pool play and need two more wins to make sectional finals. The Mayor spoke on recent floods, due to heavy rains and stated he met with the Public Works Director. They reviewed what was done in response to last year's flooding as it pertained to the clearing of sewer lines. The Mayor also met with the City Engineer who had done a survey in the hardest hit areas and found there were no major problems present with sewer lines. The Mayor also met with Metropolitan Water Reclamation District and one of their Commissioners today and reviewed the Water Reclamation Districts procedures on handling heavy rains. The Mayor then recognized City Engineer, John Fitzgerald who stated our drains are geared for a five year rain event and no matter how large our pipes are the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District could not handle the flow of water. The Mayor stated the estimated cost on a separated sewer system to divert rain Water is over \$150 million dollars and he reached out to Congressmen Lipinski for possible Federal assistance. The Mayor reiterated that there is nothing a local municipality can do, at this point, to correct the flooding rains and the situations they caused. The Mayor stated he plans on having a Town Hall meeting to discuss what the residents can do to prevent this type of flooding, the possibility of Installing relief systems and explore the cost. The Mayor stated he will have representatives from Public Works, the City Engineer and hopefully the Water Reclamation District.

Alderman Paul thanked the Mayor for his efforts and explained 3<sup>rd</sup> Ward residents have been hit three times in the last thirteen months and the need possibly look into the elevation levels in the 3<sup>rd</sup> ward. John Fitzgerald City Engineer stated he will look at the elevation at the levels in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Ward. The Mayor also noted that the City is also working with the Berwyn Park District for flood control within Proska Park.

- 4. A motion by Chapman, seconded by Avila, to approve including agenda addendum item D-1 to the City Council agenda, regarding the purchase of new-updated Emergency Warning Siren System Bid Opening and Tabulation. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- The minutes of the Berwyn City Council Meeting, held July 12, 2011 and the Committee of the Whole, held on July 12, 2011 were submitted. Thereafter, Boyajian made a motion, seconded by Avila, to concur and approve as submitted. The motion carried by a voice vote.
- 6. Item D-1, Bid Opening and Tabulation for the purchase of New Updated Emergency Warning Siren System. Thereafter, Chapman made a motion, seconded by Boyajian to concur and authorize the corporate authorizes and any interested parties to adjourn to the Board Room to open, tabulate and return same to City Council. The motion carried by a voice vote. Clerk Pavlik noted that we received bids from Federal Signal Safely and Security System, University Park, IL and American Signal Corporation, Milwaukee, WI.
- 7. The Berwyn Development Corporation submitted a communication regarding an Ordinances Creating Harlem TIF District and an Ordinance entitled:

The Mayor recognized Tim Angel, of the Berwyn Development Corporation, who reviewed same. Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Paul, to concur and **adopt** the Ordinance as presented and authorize the corporate authorities to affix their signatures thereto. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

8. The Berwyn Development Corporation submitted an Ordinance entitled:

Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Paul and Skryd to concur and **adopt** The Ordinance as presented. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Paul and Skryd to concur and **adopt** the Ordinance as presented and authorize the corporate authorities to affix their signatures thereto. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

Thereafter, Avila made a motion, seconded by Boyajian to concur and approve as submitted The Motion carried by a voice vote, with Skryd abstaining.
- 13. The City Clerk submitted a communication regarding the Open Meetings Act OMA Officer Certification of Deputy City Clerk Jynette Ayala Certificate of Completion for on line training. Thereafter, Skryd made a motion, seconded by Chapman to concur and approve as submitted. The motion carried by a voice vote.

Thereafter, Boyajian made a motion seconded by Chapman to concur with the recommendation of the Berwyn Zoning Board of Appeals granted permission for conational use and to adopt the Resolution and Ordinance as presented. The motion carried by the following roll call: Yeas: Chapman, Boyajian, Paul, Skryd, Avilla, Laureto. Absent: Polashek. Excused: Santoy.
- 15. The City Administrator submitted a request for approval regarding for staff to develop and disseminate RFP's via our sealed bid process for both a fire alarm installation at the Oak Park Ave. train station and masonry work at the Oak Park Ave. and Harlem Ave. trains stations. Thereafter a motion, by Chapman seconded by Boyajian to concur and grant permission. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
- 16. The City Engineer submitted a communication regarding Tabulation of Bids for the Generator/UPS Installation Project at City Hall with recommendation to award the bid to Airport Electric Company, Chicago, IL in the amount not to exceed \$248,890.00. The Mayor recognized the IT Director Jim Frank who explained the electrical issues being faced at City Hall with recent power interruptions. Thereafter, a motion, by Chapman seconded by Skryd, to concur and approve as submitted. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
- 17. The City Finance Director submitted the 2010 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (Audit.) Thereafter, Chapman made a motion, seconded by Skryd, to concur and accept the matter as informational. The motion carried by a voice vote.

#### **MEMBERS PRESENT**

Messrs: Malina, Castaldo, Miller, Fejt, Chrastka, Persin and Mrs. Hernandez.

WHEREAS, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the BERWYN ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS, (the "BOARD"), in a PUBLIC MEETING of the BOARD on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2011, having considered all the facts presented at the Hearing of this matter;

WHEREAS, the APPLICANT has been duly informed if: (a) the BOARD fully or partially approves the request of the APPLICANT; OR (b) the BOARD rejects the request of the APPLICANT; OR (c) the BOARD has made no recommendation to the CITY COUNCIL; and the CITY COUNCIL wholly or partially approves the request of the APPLICANT, the APPLICANT must obtain a building permit within SIX (6) MONTHS after the date that the ORDINANCE is enacted;

The BOARD has reached its decision after considering the testimony of the witnesses and the documents presented both prior to and during the Hearing, briefly set forth as follows:

- 1. Mr. Marvin Britt testified on behalf of the applicant. He stated that he and his mother, Willene, have entered into a contract to purchase the property at 6401-6413 W. 16<sup>th</sup> Street, and that contract is contingent upon approval of their requested Conditional Use to operate a Day Care business. If approved, then they will operate the business under the corporate name of "Fresh Start Day Care, Inc., and that corporation will lease the premises from them. Ms Willene Britt is the President of that Illinois corporation.
- This is a one story brick building situated on a lot measuring 90 feet in width from north to south and 122.13' in length from east to west. (Mr. Chrastka, the area investigator states that according to his measurements, the length is closer 110 feet.) The building, measuring from 16th street north at the west lot line is 70 feet and there is a 20 foot asphalt area from the north wall of the building to the north lot line. There is a garage like building at the northeast rear of the lot measuring about 17 feet from north to south, and 50 feet from east to west, with a space of about 3 feet between the north wall of the main building and the south wall of the garage. About Eighty Percent (80%) of this building has been unoccupied for guite some time and about 20% of the building area is occupied by a barber shop, that is leasing on a month to month basis. Someone apparently started to rehab the building awhile ago and then abandoned the project, so most of the building is still gutted. The applicant is proposing to have a loading zone for drop off of the children at the east Ridgeland side of the building, and that area is about 30 feet to the street. They have discussed the usage of this area and possibility of a curb cut and usage of part of the sidewalk for temporary use as parking spaces with the Building Director. Parents will drive through this area in a southerly direction, exit from the cars, walk their children to the front 16th street entrance about 40 feet, and then return to their cars and exit from the area onto 16th street.
- 3. The applicant proposes to use the entire bullding for operation of a Day Care Center for whatever capacity is allowable, presently estimated at 100 to 110 children, ranging in age from 6 weeks to 12 years. They propose to completely refurblsh the inside of the building, including new plumbing, electricity, heating and air conditioning which will probably be located on the roof top, and partition off at least seven

- (7) class rooms, with 4 childrens bath rooms, one adult bathroom, and a full kitchen. There presently are five (5) entrances to the building at 16<sup>th</sup> street which will remain, with one entrance to be designated as the main entrance, and the other entrances to be used in emergency situations. In addition to street parking, they may be able to set aside 2 to 3 parking spaces in the asphalt area. Mr. Miller and Mrs. Hernandez pointed out that there is a bus stop at 16<sup>th</sup> and Ridgeland, and only 2 hour parking between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. on 16<sup>th</sup> Street. The witness stated that they may request a change in parking on 16<sup>th</sup> street to more than 2 hours, as has been done in other areas with similar businesses, and that many of the employees will live in close proximity to this building and can walk or take public transportation to the site, and parents will only leave their cars in the loading zone for a short while when dropping off their children.
- 4. The witness testified that for the last 12 years they have been operating a successful Day Care business located at Harlem and North Avenue in Chicago, and also another location at 5858 w. Roosevelt Road, with about 105 children in attendance, and those facilities shall remain open. This business will be regulated and licensed by the Illinois Department of Children's Family Services (DCFS), and must renew their license every 3 years. Proposed hours of operation shall be from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 P.M., Monday through Friday, with no evening or week end hours. Considering their estimate of children to attend, they will probably hire about 20 employees, those that are teachers, should have at least an associates degree with some training and/or experience in child care, and teachers assistants should have at least a high school diploma. They will provide preparation for Kindergarten up to 5 years of age, and the curriculum for the other ages shall be suited for that age group, with most of the teaching from 3 years of age and up, to be provided by tested and approved computer programs. The children get points for completing various programs. They will have parent-teacher sessions to evaluate the progress of each child and will work closely with the Public School System and the Head Start Systems to help prepare the curriculum.
- 5. The food will be catered for breakfast, lunch and afternoon snacks, with an occasional use of the kitchen for preparing other foods. One person with kitchen and dietary food training, shall supervise the kitchen operation. They will also be supervised by the Berwyn Health Department and obtain a license to serve food if necessary. There may be some subsidies to children to help pay the cost from the

Federal or State Governments, but as is the case in their present locations, they do not expect to be restricted in any way by the parents accepting such funds.

6. The number of teachers they will hire shall depend on the ratio of teachers to children, as follows:

15 months to 23 months. 1 teacher for every 5 children; 24 months to 35 months. 1 teacher for every 8 children; 36 months to 5 years. 1 teacher for every 10 children; 6 years to 12 years. 1 teacher for every 20 children.

- 7. Their records shall contain names of the family doctor and others that can be notified in case of an emergency, and in serious medical emergencies they will call the 911 number. Parents, in almost all cases, shall schedule their children for a 10 hour session each day, and the starting times can vary. They also plan to tuck point the front of the building and install some canopies. Any signs will be affixed to the canopies. The witness indicated that their present Chicago location is very similar to this site so they feel very confident that they can control the parking and traffic flow in a way not to add to the overall congestion in the area.
- 8. They have no special plans for the garage at the rear of the building so it probably will be used for storage initially. The asphalt area shall be fenced and part will be used for outside activities for the children.
- 9. Willene Britt testified that the Easter Seal Governing Body will get involved in recommending some of the curriculum programs.
- 10. Mr. Chrastka, the appointed area investigator, presented a written report which is incorporated by reference in this resolution. He met with Ms Willene Britt at the proposed site on July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2011 and distributed notices of the meeting on both sides of the 1500 blocks of Ridgeland and Elmwood Avenues and the north side of 16<sup>th</sup> street from Ridgeland to Elmwood on July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2011. The main building faces 16<sup>th</sup> street and measures approximately 110' west to east and 70' north to south. Its west and south walls are on or close to the lot line. An 8' wide public sidewalk extends form the building to the curb parallels and the public entrance is from 16<sup>th</sup> street.

The east wall which faces Ridgeland Avenue runs north and south for about 90 feet and the east wall is the east wall of both the main building and the secondary building located at the northeast portion of the lot, so it gives the appearance of being just one building on the site. Mr. Chrastka describes the main building, secondary building, and open spaces on the site in great detail in his report.

The buildings occupy 80 to 85% of the site, and about a quarter of the main building is in use as a barber shop. The rest of the building is vacant- either being rehabbed or gutted. The secondary building at the northeast rear of the lot, measures about 50' east to west by 18' north to south, and is separated from the main building by about 4 feet. The separation provides rear entry to some of the store fronts facing 16<sup>th</sup> street. The secondary building at the northeast corner of the lot appears to be unoccupied.

There is an open area on the north side of the building measuring about 20' north to south. It opens to the alley on the west and is bounded on the south and east by the structures. The north end is bounded by a fence between the site and the neighbors property. It appears that the people involved with the barber shop park their cars in that space.

There are two electric meters on the building behind the barber shop and there are empty service positions for electric meters behind the unoccupied spaces, and one gas meter on the building with remaining four meter positions on the gas manifold missing and removed.

The applicant intends to convert the entire building into a Day Care Center for children ages 6 weeks to ten. (Applicant said 12 years in his testimony). The open area on the north side of the building will be made into a play area. The applicant said that they are discussing nine private parking spaces in the loading zone with the Building Director. The concept is to create diagonal spaces by reconstructing the existing parkway and sidewalk areas using the 90' north to south and unspecified width east to west. For comparison purposes a nearby diagonal parking facility has space for nine cars in a 120' X 11' area.

The site would be compatible with Lincoln middle school and the Berwyn Cultural Center which is kitty corner across 16<sup>th</sup> street and Havlicek grade school which is a block to the north. Commercial

activity is a gas station and an auto repair shop on opposite corners, and the remaining area is residential.

Mr. Chrastka voted in favor of granting a Conditional Use to operate a Day Care Center as requested. Messrs: Malina, Castaldo, Fejt, Persin, and Mrs. Hernandez, all agreed with the area investigator and voted in favor of granting a Conditional Use to operate a Day Care Center as requested, and Mr. Miller voted against granting a Conditional Use. Those in favor stated: (1) That the parking and traffic problems are not insurmountable; (2) The applicants, have a good track record and have had success in other locations in solving these problems; (3) This usage will eliminate a gutted building that has been vacant for many years and will greatly improve the area; (4) Granting this Conditional Use will be in harmony with the schools and the cultural center in the area. Mr. Miller stated that parking is too much of a problem and that he could not approve the Conditional Use for a Day Care Center at this location.

The final vote was 6 to 1 in favor of granting a Conditional Use to allow the operation of a Day Care Center in accordance with the testimony at the hearing, documents presented, and this resolution.

This resolution was prepared from the notes taken at the meeting of all the witnesses, questions that were asked & answered, and the votes and comments that were given by the Board Members at the meeting.
