

BERWYN CITY COUNCIL
DECEMBER 23, 2008

1. The regular meeting of the Berwyn City Council was called to order by Mayor O'Connor at 8:07 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Ramos, Weiner, Day, Phelan, Lovero. Absent: Skryd, Erickson. Thereafter, Chapman made a motion, seconded by Day to excuse Aldermen Skryd and Aldermen Erickson. The motion carried by a voice vote.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited, the Mayor then wished everyone joy for the holidays a moment of silence was observed for health and wellbeing for all.
3. The Open Forum portion of the meeting was announced. Resident Lisa Marada of 6814 W. 30th Place spoke regarding the snow removal and read a letter regarding and supplied same to Clerk for minutes. Aldermen Chapman reported receiving 46 calls regarding the same lack of snow removal. Thereafter, the Mayor recognized the Public Works Director, Patrick Ryan, who stated that crews will be out in full force on Wednesday to alleviate the situation.
4. The minutes of the regular City Council meeting and the Committee of the Whole held on December 9, 2008 were submitted. Thereafter, Lovero made a motion, seconded by Chapman, to concur and approve as amended on face item #27 and to approve the Committee of The Whole minutes as presented. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
5. Chapman made a motion, seconded by Lovero to suspend the rules and bring forth item #I-1, I-2, I-3 and I-4. Motion carried.
I-2 is a communication from the Board of Fire and Police Commission regarding the appointment of Probationary Fire Fighter Scott Waszak and a communication from Fire Chief O'Halloran regarding the promotion of John Janata to the rank of Engineer. Thereafter, Lovero made a motion, seconded by Ramos, to concur and approve as submitted. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

Mayor O'Connor then recognized Fire Fighter Waszak and Engineer Janata. Thereafter, the Clerk administered the Oath of Office.

6. A communication from The Board of Fire and Police Commissioners regarding the appointment of Probationary Police Officers, Thomas Garcia, James Grabarczyk and Casey C. Stefano. Thereafter, Lovero made a motion, seconded by Ramos, to concur and approve the appointment as submitted. Mayor O'Connor recognized the newly appointed officers, the Clerk then administered the Oath of Office.
7. A communication from the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners regarding the appointment of Lateral Transfers Police Officers, Richard Novotny, Daniel Rodriguez and Carl Gray. Lovero made a motion by, seconded by Ramos, to concur and approve the appointments as submitted. Mayor O'Connor recognized the newly appointed Police Officers; the Clerk then administered the Oath of Office.
8. A deferred communication from Alderman Chapmen regarding Sergeants promotion. Alderman Phelan made a motion to accept the matter as informational. There being no second, the Mayor recognized the motion by Lovero, seconded by Chapman, to concur and approve as submitted to fill the two Sergeants positions. Thereafter, Mayor O'Connor recognized Police Chief William Kushner who spoke regarding the matter. Thereafter, the motion carried following the call of the roll: Yeas: Chapman, Ramos, Weiner, Day, Lovero. Nays: Phelan. Excused: Skryd and Erickson.
9. The Mayor submitted a communication regarding the Tax Levy Proposal and an attached ordinance entitled:

After discussion, Lovero made a motion, seconded by Ramos, to concur and adopt ordinance as presented and authorize the corporate authorizes to affix their signatures thereto. The motion carried by the following call of the roll: Pass: Chapman. Yeas: Ramos, Weiner, Phelan, Lovero. Nays: Day. Thereafter, Chapman entered a vote of Yea. Excused: Skryd and Erickson.

13. The Board of Trustees, Berwyn Firemen's Pension Fund submitted a communication regarding Estimated Pension Cost 2009. After discussion, Chapman made a motion, seconded by Lovero, to refer the matter to the Committee of The Whole. The motion carried by a voice vote.
14. The Berwyn Police Pension Fund submitted a communication regarding Annual Municipal Compliance Report. After discussion, Weiner made a motion, seconded by Chapman, to refer the matter to the Committee of the Whole. The motion carried by a voice vote.
15. A deferred communication from the Law Department regarding the Sister City Ordinance. Thereafter, Lovero made a motion, seconded by Ramos, to defer the matter for 3 weeks. The motion carried by voice vote.
16. The Finance Director submitted a communication regarding Tax Levy Abatement Ordinances and an ordinance entitled:



21. The Library Director submitted a communication regarding request to authorize to replace recently resigned staff member. Thereafter, Chapman made a motion, seconded by Ramos, to concur, waive the hiring freeze and approve the request as submitted. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote. Thereafter, Lovero made a motion, seconded by Day, to concur and approve as submitted the request for Workmen's Compensation Insurance with National Safety with an SIR at \$600,000., in the amount of \$110,180.00. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.
23. The Finance Director submitted a communication regarding the Folgers Flag Payment, check number 340272 in the amount of \$14,781.00. Thereafter Chapman made a motion, seconded by Ramos, to concur and approve for payment. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

Thereafter, Ramos made a motion, seconded by Day, to concur and approve as submitted. The motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

26. Fire and Police committee called a meeting as previously called, for meeting, for Friday, December 26, 2008 at 6:00 p.m. for referrals.

COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE
DECEMBER 23, 2008

1. The Committee of the Whole was called to order by Mayor O'Connor at 6:27 p.m. Upon the call of the roll, the following responded present: Chapman, Ramos, Weiner, Day, Phelan, Lovero, Erickson. Absent: Skryd.
2. Lovero made a motion, seconded by Day to excuse Alderman Skryd. Motion carried.
3. Weiner made a motion, seconded by Chapman to close the Committee of the Whole for pending litigation and land acquisition at 6:28 pm. The motion carried.

The open portion of the Committee of the Whole reconvened at 7:08 pm.

Note: Alderman Erickson now absent.

4. Item J-3 and J-6 of the City Council Agenda,
 - Item J-3 CCMSI Proposal
 - Item J-6-Excess Liability & Workers Compensation Insurance Renewal Mayor referred to Megan Parrilli of TA Cummings who recommending using the Lexington Insurance Company for the General Liability and Safety National with a SIR option at \$600,000.00.
 - Miss Parrilli stated that going with Lexington will save \$2,000.00 on the premium, going with Safety National with a \$600,000 SIR would be a reduction of \$40,000.00 of the previous year and recommended switching to Safety National.
 - Alderman Chapman requested quotes to review before a decision is made on Council Agenda.
 - Miss Parrilli stated she had supplied the figures to Finance Director John Wysocki who would be more than happy to reproduce and distribute the Aldermen prior to the City Council vote.
5. City Council Item J-7;
 - Item J-7 Folgers Flag Payment. Mayor stated the Finance Director John Wysocki was looking for direction on payment.
 - Alderman Chapman stated that she had discussed the matter with Alderman Skryd and they are both in agreement with making the payment.

6. F-2 of the City Council Agenda;
- Item F-2 Strategic Planning Proposal a communication from the Mayor.

The Mayor requested direction from Council. Aldermen; Chapman, Ramos, Weiner, Day and Phelan all expressed that they were not in favor of the proposal at this time.

7. F-1 of the City Council Agenda;
- Item F-1 Tax Levy Proposal a communication from the Mayor. Mayor is asking for direction from the Council.
 - Alderman Chapman stated she is in agreement with the 0%, but not by cutting the Police and Fire Pension Levy and is suggesting lowering the corporate levy and presented the Council with a hand amended proposal (see attached). Discussion ensued between Mayor O'Connor and Alderman Chapman regarding the levy at the lower levels.
 - Mayor stated the additional funding to the pensions can be made by cutting the budget later and appropriating from the general fund.


8. Mayor recognized Finance Director John Wysocki who handed out the insurance proposals for items J-3 and J-6.

MINUTES
PUBLIC HEARING
TAX LEVY 2008
DECEMBER 23, 2008

1. A Public Hearing regarding the proposed City of Berwyn 2008 Property Tax Levy was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Clerk Pavlik. Present: Mayor O'Connor, Aldermen Chapman, Ramos, Weiner, Phelan, Lovero. Also present, Finance Director John Wysocki. A sign in sheet is attached.
2. Clerk Pavlik read legal notice of Proposed Property Tax Levy into record, and provided a certificate of publication for the record (see attached).
3. Clerk Pavlik presented the Proposed 2008 Tax Levy and noted that the Mayor O'Connor has presented two separate Tax Levies; one at a 0% increase and one at a 5% increase (see attached) as were presented for the City Council Agenda. Mayor O'Connor then referred to Finance Director John Wysocki who gave a PowerPoint presentation and explained the 0% Tax Levy (see attached PowerPoint). Mr. Wysocki also reviewed the 5% proposed increase.
4. Comments: Mayor O'Connor opened the floor to comments from the Aldermen, there being none, the Mayor opened up comments to the public.
 - Tom O'Halloran from the Berwyn Police Department Pension Board spoke regarding the levy figures, from the last levy and stating he is not sure that the last years numbers are legal, nor has any idea how the previous Finance Director came up with those numbers, which this year's numbers were based on.
 - Aldermen then questioned the police department's communication and the actuarial numbers.
 - The Mayor then recognized Jerry Marzzullo who spoke on behalf of the Fire Department Pension Board and referred to the actuarial evaluation, and stated that the proposed 0% levy numbers would not legally meet the state requirements for funding. The Mayor then referred page 58 and 59 of last years audit regarding the amounts levied for each fund, and stated this represents an increase, and stated this is the only amount levied through the tax and the city may make additional contributions out of the general fund.
 - Mayor O'Connor then recognized a resident Marlene Carmela, 3539 Highland, questioned the impact on the residences and business owners in the community. Finance Director Wysocki, stated it is about a 365.00 increase on a \$250,000 home if the city were to pass a 5% increase.



- Alderman Chapman then questioned the Levy at the 0% increase for the library fund and questioned why the two budget proposals from the library, were not given to the aldermen.
- Mayor O'Connor then recognized John Chrastka, President of the Library Board who spoke on the two scenarios' for the library funding and previously provided drafts of his proposed budget to the Mayor and Finance Director at an additional 5% for the library fund, which would be \$128,000 and explained the uses for the additional funds, which included a new HVAC unit and other building repairs and needs.

5. There being no further comments or questions to come before the Public Hearing, Clerk Pavlik, adjourned at 6:26 p.m.

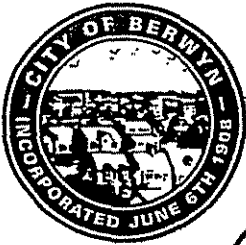

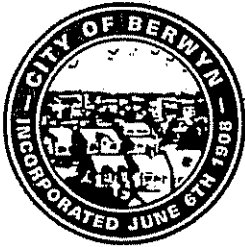

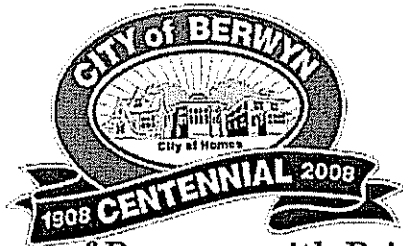

Re: Amendment/Revisions to Parking Ordinance 32nd Street and Harlem

Dear Mayor O'Connor:

The following are the recommendations of my clients to amend Ordinance 08-65 passed by the City Council earlier this year:

Section 484.01(3) provides that permits can only be issued annually and are not refundable. We are requesting that the permits be issued either quarterly or semiannually.

Section 484.01(c)(2) should be stricken to allow transferability between residents who move or sell their unit.

Section 484.01(4) c) allows the City Collector to promulgate Rules and Regulations to supplement the Ordinance. In my opinion, it may be easier to have the City Collector promulgate rules and regulations that allow the permits be transferable between residents in the event that a unit owner moves or sells his unit. The new resident would be required to register his vehicle with City Hall. We are also requesting that rules be promulgated that allow individual spots to be assigned. This would allow residents to select a specific spot that they may want for the proximity to their unit or if they have cleaned the spot out during a heavy snow storm they would be guaranteed that spot was open when they returned.

Finally, there has been some discussion that guest parking may be available to residents purchasing a permit. Since there are a limited number of spots available my clients would be opposed to offering guest parking in these spots.

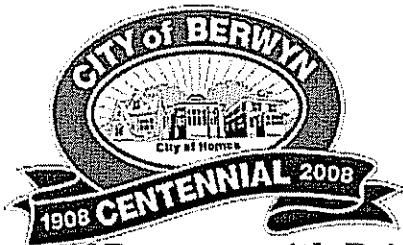

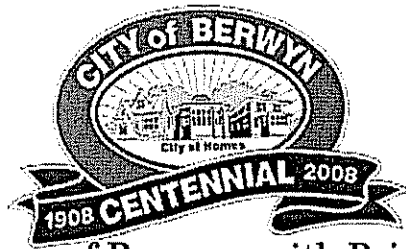

Ladies and Gentlemen:

At our last meeting the City Council voted to promote the next two (2) sergeants from the police promotion list. It has been my position for the entire discussion on this subject that since we did not hire additional officers in 2008, there would be no one to take the place of those who would be promoted. To promote two (2) patrolmen and not replace them on the duty roster serves only the interests of those next in line on the promotion list. The residents of Berwyn will not be any safer with the two (2) promotions.

I have maintained that the reason we did not hire additional police or promote to the sergeant position was because the action by the City Council in passing a budget is not an order to spend each dollar budgeted, but to limit the amount spent. It is the responsibility of the Mayor, the Finance Director and all Department Directors to make every effort to balance the budget in any way possible. It has been no surprise to anyone the revenues have been down the entire year of 2008. Every effort has been made to cut expenses, including delaying the hiring of any additional police officers and employee layoffs, in order to close the gap between revenue and expenses. In July the Finance Director projected that if the City continued to spend as directed in the budget, given the lack of revenue, the budget shortfall would have been in excess of \$2 million.

I realize everyone would like more police but with the current status of more than ten (10) members of the Police Department (2 supervisors and 8 patrolmen) off due to Workman's Compensation injuries, it is very obvious that we do not need more supervisors when the number of patrol officers is down by eight (8) due to injuries. I would also like to add that our commitment to send our sergeants and lieutenants to "Staff and Command" training has also caused some of the overtime incurred. Long discussions with the Police Chief about this subject has revealed the fact the Police Chief's decision to twice deny the grievances to promote anyone to the two (2) sergeant positions was based on the loss of City revenue and the need to cut costs. I view the actions of the City Council to demand these promotions be made is an insult to Chief Kushner and an effort to undermine his ability to manage a budget and effectually run his Department. The City Council approved these promotions at the time of the budget passage and again at our last City Council meeting. Unfortunately, the process for

promotions requires the Police Chief to instruct the Fire and Police Commission to promote the next two (2) patrolmen on the Sergeant's List. Since the Chief has twice denied the grievances to promote due to loss of revenue, there is still no reason to spend these monies to promote. While the Police Chief may have responded affirmatively to a question from the members of the City Council "Do you need more sergeants?" He realizes we must balance our needs and wants with what we can afford and with the dramatic drop in revenue for the City we must live within our means.

The 2009 Budget which I presented included three (3) new patrol officers, who were sworn in at our last City Council meeting. Those three (3) officers will graduate from the academy and complete their training by late June. The Finance Director, Police Chief and I felt confident enough in the 2009 Budget to move forward with the hiring of the three (3) additional officers. Also included in the 2009 Budget is the expenditure for two (2) sergeants to be promoted approximately July 1, 2009, to coincide with the completion of training by the three (3) new officers.

There has been much discussion about this being my decision not to promote as being political. While it is easier to point fingers and hurl allegations the fact is this administration and the aldermen must balance costs with the ability to pay versus the wants and needs of the community. I can assure you there is nothing more involved in this decision. I firmly believe there is no need for me to veto this expense because the City Council can not order the Police Chief to request the promotions but in order to satisfy all concerned, I will formally veto this expense based on all of the reasons included in this communication.

Ladies and Gentlemen,

In 2007, the Chief of Police requested, and we voted to approve, two new Sergeant positions in the year 2008, thus maintaining an effective span of control, and reduce supervisory overtime cost. In recent communication with the chief, he reiterated the need for filling these positions. The positions were agreed to be filled by adding one sergeant as of 1 January 2008, and filling the second position on 1 July 2008 and back filling the vacant patrolman positions according. This was further agreed to in the collective bargaining agreement between the City of Berwyn, and the police union and also approved by the city council in an 8 to 0 vote of the 2008 city budget. These sergeant positions are yet to be filled.

The cost the taxpayers are paying in overtime now, and the monies to be paid out in looming legal fees fighting the unions in a vain attempt to negate what we have already agreed to in a binding contract, is nothing compared to what the taxpayers will be forced to pay in restitution if a supervisor who has been subject to constant 7 days a week work schedule is involved in a life and death situation that results negatively to either the life of a police officer, or an innocent citizen.

My motion is to immediately fill the 2 positions of sergeant. We already voted to make the positions, we have voted unanimously on the 2008 budget and the line items and money required for them are there. I ask my fellow council members to consider the needs of our constituents and to join me in voting aye, and to proceed to fill the positions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety..

Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to complete and submit the Membership Application attached hereto, as well as any and all other steps reasonably necessary to secure membership to Sister Cities International.

Section 3. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 895,
SECTION .02 IMPOSITION; RATE; VIOLATIONS
OF THE BERWYN CODIFIED ORDINANCES
IN THE CITY OF BERWYN, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois (the "City") is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs (the "Home Rule Powers"); and

WHEREAS, the City of Berwyn desires to amend Section .02 of Chapter 895 of the Codified Ordinance of the City of Berwyn, Illinois and entitled "Imposition; Rate; Violations.; and

WHEREAS, after due deliberation the City Council finds it in the best interest of the City of Berwyn to increase the Vehicle Fuel Tax imposed by the City by two cents per gallon.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois, pursuant to its home-rule authority, as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 895.03, entitled Imposition; Rate; Violations is hereby amended by increasing the amount of vehicle fuel tax imposed by substituting and placing in its stead:

895.02 Imposition; Rate; Violations.

A tax is hereby created upon the privilege of purchasing or using in the City vehicle fuel purchased in a sale at retail. The tax shall be at a rate of three cents (\$0.03) per gallon of vehicle fuel. The ultimate incidence of and liability for payment of the tax shall be upon the purchaser or user of the vehicle fuel, and nothing in this chapter shall be construed to impose tax upon the occupation of selling or distributing vehicle fuel. It shall be a violation of this chapter for any distributor or retail dealer to fail to add this tax to the retail price of vehicle fuel or to absorb the tax. The tax shall be in addition to any and all other taxes.

SECTION 2: If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 3: All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby amended or repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

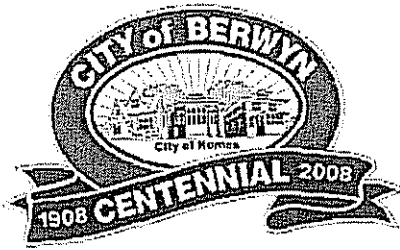

WHEREAS, the City of Berwyn desires to amend Section .05 of Chapter 462 of the Codified Ordinance of the City of Berwyn, Illinois and entitled "License Fees"; and

WHEREAS, after due deliberation the City Council finds it in the best interest of the City of Berwyn to increase certain license fees by five dollars (\$5) each:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Berwyn, Cook County, Illinois, pursuant to its home-rule authority, as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 462.05, entitled License Fees is hereby amended by substituting and placing in its stead:

462.05 License Fees
