



**Grant Award:** HUD has awarded Cook County \$2M over three years to remediate lead hazards in 120 low-income units in suburban Cook County. The grant funds will be administered by Cook County Department of Planning and Development (CCDPD) as the lead applicant, in partnership with the Cook County Department of Public Health. Over 95% of grant funds will be used for direct lead hazard control activities.

**Remediation Priority Areas:** Units will be remediated in the following communities that are at high risk for lead poisoning:

Berwyn, IL 60402	Calumet Park, IL 60409	Maywood, IL 60153
Blue Island, IL 60406	Cicero, IL 60804	Riverdale, IL 60827
Calumet City, IL 60409	Dolton, IL 60419	Robbins, IL 60472

**Approach:** This program will provide lead remediation (braided with Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Relief-funded flood mitigation assistance [CDBG-DR]) in eligible low-income units in the nine priority areas in suburban Cook County that are high-risk for lead poisoning. The program is consistent with the consolidated plan for suburban Cook County and addresses significant documented community needs.

**Remediation:** It is expected that approximately 120 homes will be remediated of lead hazards with a grant award of \$2,000,000, with 12 more remediated by using local funds for a total of 132 units completed within the three-year project period.
