**The Berwyn City Council Minutes of the Regular Meeting of June 27, 2023**

Mayor Lovero called the Regular Meeting to Order at 8:00 p.m. Clerk Paul called the roll. The following Alderpeople responded present in chambers: Lennon, Woywod, Leja, Fejt, Pabon, Ruiz, Arenella, and Carmichael. Attendees rose to recite the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Lovero asked for a moment of silence in memory of Casey Ramirez, Community Service Officer Mark Antosiak and in support of our First Responders.

**Open Forum:** Mayor Lovero opened the floor for Open Forum. Yolanda Padilla, representing Junior Sates of America – Morton West High School Chapter thanked all who contributed to the success of the JSA Juneteenth event. Following her remarks, Mayor Lovero and Ms. Padilla acknowledged the volunteers and presented them with certificates of achievement.

**Approval of Minutes:**

The motion carried with all Alderpeople voting AYE. There were no Nays, and no abstentions.

F-3: Ald. Ruiz made the motion, seconded by Ald. Pabon, to **adopt the Ordinance** entitled: **An Ordinance Amending Depot, Business Reserved, and Municipal Permit Parking and Section 484.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Berwyn**, direct the Corporate Authorities to affix the necessary signatures and place it on its way to passage. The motion carried with all Alderpeople voting AYE. There were no Nays, and no abstentions.



**Aldermanic Committee / Ward Meetings:** Ald. Leja announced a Fire and Police Committee meeting on July 5, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. in Council Chambers. Ald. Ruiz announced a Public Works, Trees, Traffic, etc. Aldermanic Committee meeting scheduled for July 11, 2023. Time to be announced.

There being no further business before the City Council, Ald. Carmichael made the motion, seconded by Ald. Lennon, to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried by a unanimous voice vote. The meeting adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
