To our valued residents,

The City of Berwyn will be making adjustments to its water rate **effective January 1, 2024** in order to compensate for increased costs of providing reliable water service to the community.

With the rising cost of necessary infrastructure development, demand on our water system, and aging infrastructure, the approved rate increase is in line with the Water/Sewer Rate Ordinance approved by City Council in 2022. While increasing rates is never favorable, this adjustment is required in order to maintain a high-functioning water system and remain financially sound.
