**REGISTER TO VOTE:**

You can register online, in person or you can download registration forms and register through the mail. Please make sure to check the specific deadline for the form you select as dates differ depending on the method of registration.

If you have an Illinois driver's license or state ID, you may register yourself online through the Illinois State Board of Elections at <https://ova.elections.il.gov/>

Deadline to register for the Primary Election is: **March 3, 2024.**

**IN-PERSON VOTING:** Your normal polling location will be open on Tuesday, **March 19, 2024.** If you are not sure where your polling place is, the City Clerk's Office can look it up. Please contact Clerk Paul at 708-749-6451 or Deputy Clerk Anderson at 708-749-5453.

**REQUESTING A MAIL-IN BALLOT:** Any voter can request a mail-in ballot without an excuse. You can receive a mail-in ballot application from the City Clerk's Office or online at <https://www.cookcountyclerk.com/agency/ways-vote>. The deadline to apply by mail or online is **March 14, 2024.** (Your request must be received downtown by that date).

**SUBMITTING A MAIL-IN BALLOT:**

- To mail, a completed ballot **must be postmarked March 19, 2024;** or
- You can drop off your completed ballot at any EARLY VOTING site between **March 4, 2024 to March 18, 2024;** or
- You can drop off your completed ballot at your normal POLLING site on **March 19, 2024.**
- If you decide to in-person vote after receiving a mail-in ballot, you may do so. Just bring your unmarked mail-in ballot to the polling location and give it to an Election Judge.
