NEW TREE CARE WATERING TIPS DURING HOT WEATHER

When planting a new tree, proper watering is an important requirement during the first two years.

Trees may die from either too little or too much water.

One thorough deep watering is better than a dozen shallow irrigations.



QUICK TIPS

Automatic irrigation systems: consider the timing to allow for longer, less-frequent watering (approx. 20 minutes, 2 times per week).

Tight clay soils retain water for longer periods of time.



PRO TIP: The ground area around the ball (approximately 5 feet in circumference) should be saturated every 3-5 days during hot weather and every 7-10 days during normal weather conditions.
